Attractive Zebrawood riser. Very comfortable grip. This bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines; there is some faint crazing (There was a small patch of bad crazing right where the specs were written, so most of this was removed and the specs rewritten). A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in fair shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
