JUST WHEN THEY WERE FEELING GOOD ABOUT THEMSELVES

Nebraska, Pittsburgh and Texas had amazing comebacks in their games and all seemly had the momentum in their games but all three teams came up short. Nebraska came from 23 points down in the 4th quarter at Miami to force overtime only to lose 36-33 to the Hurricanes. In Iowa City, Pitt QB Nathan Peterman hit Tyler Boyd for the tying 8 yard TD with 52 seconds left only to see Marshall Koehn hit a career long 57 yard field goal as time expired for a 27-24 Hawkeye victory. In Austin, Texas QB Jerrod Heard scored on a 45 yard scramble with 1:11 left in the 4th quarter only to see PK Nick Rose miss the extra point in a heartbreaking 45-44 loss to California.

In other games this past Saturday, Urban Meyer admitted that he needs to make a decision on who is going to be the full-time quarterback at Ohio State. Cardale Jones has been mediocre at best this season and JT Barrett came off the bench to help the Buckeyes beat a scrappy Northern Illinois squad 20-13 despite 5 turnovers. Don't be surprised to see Barrett get the start vs Western Michigan. Notre Dame beat Georgia Tech 30-22 but the score doesn't reflect how dominate Notre Dame was. This is a very good Notre Dame team but it seems they have a major injury every week. Georgia absolutely destroyed South Carolina 52-20 and the Bulldogs are finally getting the attention of the nation that they deserve. This is a very solid Georgia team on both sides of the ball. Texas Tech handed Arkansas a second consecutive non-conference loss 35-24 in Fayetteville. UCLA came from behind and then had to hang on to beat BYU 24-23. Clemson, Florida State and Oklahoma all came away with wins but all of the head coaches would be the first to admit there is still a lot of improvement that needs to be made.

Two of THE BLITZ preseason top 4 teams went down at home. USC could not stop the passing of Kevin Hogan as the Trojans lost 41-31 to Stanford in the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum. At Bryant-Denny Stadium, Ole Miss upset Alabama 43-37 helped in part by 5 Alabama turnovers. Also in the SEC, LSU and RB Leonard Fournette were dominate in a 45-21 win at home vs Auburn. Toledo beat an SEC for the first time ever two weeks ago when they beat Arkansas and then last week the Rockets beat a Big 12 team for the first time ever as Toledo beat Iowa State 30-23 in double overtime. Northwestern's defense looks legit. They shut down Duke's high octane offense, holding the Blue Devils to just 10 points in a 19-10 Wildcat victory. In 3 games Northwestern has given up a grand total of 16 points this season. A few other teams that are 3-0 include Missouri, Iowa, Indiana, Syracuse, NC State, Florida, Kansas State and Texas Tech.

This coming weekend has a few intriguing games but we'll have to wait until October rolls around to see the conference/division races start to take shape. A few of the games we'll be watching closely include Maryland (2-1) traveling to Morgantown to take on West Virginia (2-0). Nobody is talking about the Mountaineers but if they get to 3-0 maybe that will change. BYU (2-1), coming off a tough loss at UCLA, will take on Michigan (2-1) in the "Big House". At AT&T Stadium, Arkansas (1-2) tries to turn their season around vs Texas A&M (3-0). In what is essentially an elimination game Mississippi State (2-1) travels to the plains to take on Auburn (2-1). As good as LSU looked vs Auburn, they better not overlook Syracuse (3-0) when the Bengal Tigers travel up to the Carrier Dome. UCLA (3-0) goes to the desert to take on Rich Rodriguez and his Arizona Wildcats (3-0). How will USC (2-1) respond after their loss to Stanford? We'll find out when they welcome Arizona State (2-1) to Los Angeles. Don't look now but California (3-0) looks like a legitimate contender. Sonny Dykes has done a great job rebuilding this program. The Golden Bears will take on Washington (2-1) this Saturday. Another big Pac-12 match-up between ranked teams is Utah (3-0) traveling to Autzen Stadium to take on the Oregon Ducks (2-1). TCU (3-0) will travel to Lubbock to take on Texas Tech (3-0) in a game that looks like it will be a high scoring shoot-out. Can Texas (1-2) turn their season around after their heartbreaking loss to Cal? They'll have an opportunity this Saturday when Oklahoma State (3-0) makes the trip down to Austin.

Back in the '90's the Tennessee-Florida game was the most anticipated game in the SEC. Back then it was Phillip Fulmer and Steve Spurrier roaming the sidelines. Now it's Butch Jones and Jim McElwain. Even though Georgia seems to be the class of the SEC's Eastern Division, the winner of this Vols-Gators match-up (CBS 3:30 PM EDT) will have a leg up in the Eastern Division race along with the Bulldogs.

Tennessee (2-1) dropped a game vs Oklahoma 2 weeks ago that they seemed to be in control of until late in the contest. It's hopeful that loss has taught the Vols how to finish a game. QB Josh Dobbs has looked pretty good so far this season but Tennessee is only as good, on offense, as their running game goes. Jalen Hurd and Alvin Kamara will be key for UT if they are to be successful. Florida QB Will Grier played the entire game for the Gators (3-0) and he was their leading rusher as well against Kentucky but RB Kelvin Taylor needs to have a big game if Florida is to come away with a victory.

Florida leads the all-time series vs Tennessee 25-19-0. Tennessee actually won 13 of the first 15 games of the series vs Florida but things have changed dramatically as the Gators have won the last 10 consecutive games vs the Vols. If Tennessee is to break this streak, this might be the season to do it. The fact that this game is in Gainesville, makes us look harder at Florida, but Tennessee seems to have a more complete team, so we're picking the Vols to beat the Gators in a game the should go down to the wire.





COLLEGE FOOTBALL HIDDEN GEMS: COLORADO'S FOLSOM FIELD



Home to the best live mascot (Ralphie) in all of college football, Colorado's Folsom Field is known as much for the beauty of the Colorado Rocky Mountains that tower over the stadium as much as anything, but there is much more to this facility than just the home field of the 1990 National Champion Colorado Buffaloes.

When it opened in 1924, it was known as Colorado Stadium and that was the name for the first 20 years but in 1944, it was changed to Folsom Filed in honor of their late coach, Fred Folsom.

In 1967 the running track was removed and the field was lowered to add seats towards the sidelines but the school didn't add seats in the lower south endzone, instead an incline was formed from the previous level of the playing surface to the new playing surface and that hill remains one of the more iconic features of any stadium in college football. Today it is black with C O L O R A D O in gold block letters.

There have not been a lot of expansions through the years but everything, that has been done, has focused more on quality rather than quantity. The west side press box was expanded and renovated but the east side luxury suites and club seating that were added in 2003 was the last major expansion of the facility. Recently some seats were added to the northeast corner of the stadium but a few seats were lost due to reconfiguration. The current seating capacity is 50,183.

Folsom Field is the 3rd highest in elevation at the Division I Football Bowl Subdivision level behind only Wyoming's War Memorial Stadium and Air Force's Falcon Stadium. This is an advantage due to the thin air which causes opponents to gasp for air in the 4th quarter.

Now in the Pac-12 Conference, Colorado seems to be on track to get things straightened out to where they can be more competitive and get back to competing for championships.

WHY MIAMI NEEDS TO PLAY ON CAMPUS

Charlotte, Minnesota, Houston, Tulane, Akron, Baylor, SMU, Stanford, UCF, Florida Atlantic, North Texas. What do those schools have in common? They are all Division I FBS schools that have constructed on-campus stadiums since

What school is missing from that list? The University of Miami located in Coral Gables, Florida. We've heard numerous excuses as to why Miami, has not built an on campus stadium through the years. Most of the time it's the "there's no room on campus to construct a stadium when, in fact, there is plenty of room. The vast area of Yaron Field just north of the football practice facility and Mark Light Field is more than big enough to construct a stadium.

Let's be honest, playing at Sun Life Stadium simply isn't working for the Hurricanes. The stadium it's self is first class, especially with the renovations going on. It's just too far away from the campus. This is not like USC and the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum, which lies across the street (Exposition Blvd) from the USC campus, Sun Life Stadium is 30 miles from Coral Gables. When the Hurricanes played at the Orange Bowl from 1937-2007, attendance wasn't anything to brag about but at least it was a reasonable distance from Coral Gables for the students.

Since Miami moved to Sun Life Stadium, their home record has been a respectable 31-14 .689 and their attendance has been okay averaging approximately 50,000 per-game but it's the "feel" of the Miami home games that's been lacking. The collegiate atmosphere is not there. A Miami Hurricanes home game feels more like an NFL game than a college football game. This is not disrespecting NFL games because we all love the NFL, it's just that Saturday college football games and Sunday NFL games have always had a different feel about them and that's just the way it is. Having a strong student section is so important and Miami's is not as strong and boisterous as other ACC schools' student sections.

To the right we've got 3 recently constructed stadiums that Miami could use as models to build an on-campus home football stadium. Obviously cost would dictate a lot, but if they could borrow some of the ideas from the University of Minnesota's high dollar TCF Bank Stadium (\$310 Million) that has all the bells & whistles, the University of Houston's cost efficient TDECF Stadium (\$128 Million) and Tulane's low budget Yulman Stadium (\$75 Million), the Hurricanes could get something that might draw more students, get the students more excited and more involved. An on-campus stadium could also possibly help recruiting which could propel the program back to the elite status that they used to reside.

Building an on-campus stadium is not a guarantee to turn things around for Miami but, in our opinion, the Sun Life Stadium experiment has not worked and this could only help the long term viability of the football program. As of now there are no plans in place for this.
