
NEW BUSINESSES IN TOWNMichelle Geller, Economic Dev Mgr.

DID YOU KNOW....



About Pure Water Oceanside?

Did you know that Oceanside had been working for years to increase our water supply by purifying and reusing our waste water? Pure Water Oceanside will purify recycled water to create a new, local source of high-quality drinking water that is clean, safe, drought-proof and environmentally sound. The program will produce enough water to provide more than 30% of the city's water supply!



Here's how:

- Ultra-filtration Filters remove bacteria and suspended solids from reclaimed water.
- Reverse Osmosis Ultra-fine filters remove salt, viruses, pharmaceuticals, bacteria, and chemicals.
- Ultraviolet Light and Advanced Oxidation. The final polishing step neutralizes any remaining substances.
- Injection Minerals are added then the water is injected via 3 wells into the Mission Basin aquifer.
- Treatment Water is extracted from the aquifer and treated again at the city's Mission Basin Groundwater Purification Facility.
- Delivery- The water is distributed to customers!

OCNA IS WORKING FOR YOU!

The Board is meeting regularily with city officials to keep our Seaside neighborhood safe and clean!



- The city is working to identify and paint red curbs on critical intersections to improve visibility for drivers and neighbors.
- We are currently working on a pre-Coast Hwy Redevelopment plan for traffic calming and cut through traffic Tremont, Ditmar, and Freeman streets.
- We successfully worked with the city to stop the unpermitted harboring of homeless reducing negative impacts and crimes.
- We continue to work with staff on pressing the NCTD project for more transparancy and mitigate negative bus circulation impacts.

COAST HWY IMPROVEMENT IS COMING!

Once funds are identified, the project could happen as soon as 2025. The improvements will be located on Coast Highway from Surfrider Way, south to Oceanside Boulevard. Improvements will include:

- Much-needed repaving along the stretch of roadway
- Road "diet" from four lanes to two in the location above
- Roundabouts at Coast Highway and Civic Center Drive, Michigan Avenue, Washington Avenue, Wisconsin Avenue and West Street
- Curb ramp, bulb-out calming curbs, crosswalks with flashing lights
- Bike lanes and bike racks
- Improved sidewalks, raised medians, and new landscaping and
- New benches, street furniture, and trash cans!

SEAGAZE TOWER TRADES HOTEL FOR APTS!

The developer has proposed and will be heading to the Planning Commission to replace the 64 proposed hotel rooms to studio apartments. This will increase the total apartment units to 179.
