**MENINGITIS AT YOAKUM**

A genuine case of cerebro-spinal meningitis has developed at Yoakum. The patient is a 4-year-old negro boy. Dr. Walker diagnosed the case, and the other physicians of the city agreed on his diagnosis. They made a "lumbar puncture" and the fluid extracted contained considerable pus and the meningitis germ, says the Herald. Another case has also developed at Gonzales.

**Death of Maj. Thos. B. Womack.**

Major Thomas Bowling Womack, aged 84 years, a pioneer citizen of Victoria, died here last night at 11 o'clock. Mr. Womack was a son of Jesse and Francis Carter Womack, and was born in Greenville, Alabama, April 1, 1828. He removed to Brandon, Mississippi, when a young man, and was married there in 1850 to Miss Ann Elizabeth Shelton, daughter of W. H. and E. A. Shelton, and a native of Danville, Virginia. Mr. and Mrs. Womack settled in East Texas in 1857, and removed to Victoria in 1865. Mr. Womack engaged in the cattle business soon after coming here, and at one time was numbered among the wealthiest stockmen of Southern Texas. Mrs. Womack died August 27, 1919. Three children survive: J. B. Womack and Mrs. R. L. Groce of this city and Mrs. L. W. Hensley of Dallas. The funeral took place from the residence of the decedent's son, 607 North Glass Street, this afternoon at 4:30 o'clock. Rev. James F. Pennybacker, the Methodist minister, assisted by Rev. Paul T. Prentiss, the pastor of the Episcopal Church, officiating. The pall bearers were M. H. Williams, August Wedemeler, Thos. J. Sterne, Dr. Francis J. Cooke, W. B. Dailey and P. B. McNeil, and the interment was made in the Evergreen Cemetery. The obsequies were largely attended, and the floral offerings many and beautiful.

**Change in Train Schedule.**

It developed today that the additional change that is to be made in the abominable passenger train schedule on this division of the Galveston, Harrisburg & San Antonio Railway Thursday will provide no better service, but only affect the mixed train from Port Lavaca, which will arrive here an hour and a half later. Practically the only advantage of this change will be to the Railroad Company, as it will reduce the salaries of the trainmen \$15 or \$20 a month.


