DESCRIPTION: Norm Richards was a well-known bowyer in the 1960s who produced a line of high-end bows, such as the Cardinal, Fantastique, and Fascination. His bows are fairly rare and have become collector's items. This Cardinal is an attractive shooter that has been partially reconditioned. No delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in good condition. No chips, dings or cracks. Some yellowing of the limbs. No stress lines or crazing. A few scratches and scuffs on the limbs. The main flaw with this bow is the several filled holes (3 in the riser and 5 sight holes on the upper back limb—see pics). Overall, this is still a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
