CM Evaluators will evaluate the performance evaluations through **June 21** and the results will be posted to the MTAC Online System by **June 29, 2020.**

The video guidelines are currently posted on your <u>Teacher Portal</u>. The technique chart for the students is located in the instrument CM syllabus. If your student does not have a technique chart for your evaluation, you can request one by filling out <u>this form.</u>

Please note, voice students do not have a technique chart.

Information on accessing the online theory exam will be sent in June. Students can take their theory exam at any time during the month of June. All exams must be completed by **June 30, 2020**.

CM Teachers in MTACLB-

Please read the email below. They are now **requiring** that PDF's of your student's CM music be uploaded along with their videos. Please communicate with your student immediately so they can have these ready to upload with their videos beginning tomorrow, 6/4-6/14. They will send students a link where they will upload everything.

For students with iphones, they can use the "notes" app (that comes with the phone), and click on the camera then scan their music. Once scanned they can email it to themselves/send it to their computers/save on their device. Another good app for scanning is "turboscan" available in the App Store. Scanning with a traditional scanner works, as does taking a picture of the music if they don't have access to any other resources. If they take pictures, they can send/email the pictures to their computer and "export" the pictures as PDF's.


