- With Rancho operations manager develop and implement capital investment projects to improve process capability, health safety and environmental compliance.
- Directly supervises employees in the Technical department. Carries out supervisory responsibilities in accordance with the organization's policies and applicable laws.

• Responsibilities include interviewing, hiring, and training employees; planning, assigning, and directing work; appraising performance; rewarding and disciplining employees; addressing complaints and resolving problems.
