

MARION TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS MEETING August 9, 2018 at the Township Building

Present: Archie Gettig Jr., John (Rick) Dillon, Tanner Day and Angel Emery

Chairman Gettig, called the meeting to order at 7:34 p.m., pledge of allegiance was recited at the Public Hearing held directly before the BOS meeting.

On a motion by Gettig and 2nd by Day, motion passed to approve July 12, 2018 meeting minutes as presented 3-0.

Public Comments: Roan walked the park and would like to see the park path re done to ADA standards, bathrooms pumped and concession stand pressure washed. Roan also would like stones replaced in front of his house, Dillon checked roads because of complaints received after the storms, and there was discussion about stones versus grass in front of houses at Walnut Ridge. Roan received a complaint from his neighbors, The Shaffer's, about two weeks ago. Complaints should be directed to the township. Discussion was held about the berms being maintained better with previous employees being in charge and the fact the Walnut Ridge has never been graded.

Scott Rhoat spoke about Bellefonte EMS and presented the board with a 2018 Fact Sheet. Bellefonte EMS would like to have a meeting with all 10 municipalities that they serve but are trying to be careful of the Sunshine Law, they would like to see at least one supervisor there, no decision would be made at said meeting. Roan questioned Rhoat about the ambulance club and suggested the township help push that drive next time around as well as put information on the township website.

Head Road Master Report- Gettig reported on work that was completed in July, Gettig didn't work much in July due to family obligations. Gettig will contact Matt Kenepf to go look at complaints received about

recent paving. There were a few complaints received after the storms, the township is working to fix any problems that they can.

Penn DOT- Letter for approval was received for the red light application, red light will be placed at the intersection of Marine Sgt. David Emery Highway (SR 0026) and I-80 West Bound Ramp B (SR 8010).

History of Marion Township- On a motion by Dillon and 2nd by Gettig, motion passed to get sales tax license 3-0.

Bellefonte Borough- Proposed re-zoning public hearing August 20, 2018, just an FYI, no comments made.

DEP- Evaluation for possible re-designation of Fishing Creek basin in Clinton and Centre counties, just an FYI, no comments made.

Centre County Office of Adult Services- PHARE Rental Assistance, FYI, no comments made.

Other Discussion Items:

Budget meeting in October, in previous years there would be an appreciation dinner for employees and elected officials.

On a motion by Gettig and 2nd by Day, motion passed to pay the bills and accept the Treasurer's Report as presented 3-0.
