May Director's Message



Thanks to all in attendance this past Tuesday for our meet and greet. The spring weather has been consistent with up and down temperature swings. It looks like maybe we are going to have some summer temps for the next week or so! Some of our trees have been confused with the up and down temperatures with a freezing temp overnight at our place just this week.

We just heard from our patch lady that some of our shirts with the new logo are finished.

We will pick them up so we can bring them to the chapter to show you.

May is motorcycle awareness month. So, if you have some yard signs, it's time to put them up. If you would like one, let me know. I have several at home.

Planting season is winding down, but the spraying season is in full swing. This will mean there will be more large sprayers and spreaders on the roads as well as the large supporting tank trucks. Some will be slower traveling and/or parking on the side of the rural roads. Use extra caution when travelling through the countryside. There is rain being predicted for the next few days and could lead to some mud on the roads also—some more hazards to be aware of.

As we begin the riding season, each of us should prepare mentally for a safe riding season. Listed below are some additional hazards to watch for.

- Gravel, sand, or salt from winter road applications.
- Construction zones. They are popping up all over.
- Potholes there are many new potholes in the roads from the winter. Watch for them as you begin riding. I saw on the news that there are more this year than ever because of the alternate freezing and thawing of the road surfaces with the milder and wetter overall winter.

Many of these potholes are 5 or 6 inches deep and sometimes can be a foot long or longer. Imagine dropping a front motorcycle tire in that at 55 mph or more!! Disaster!

- Freshly patched holes. There may be loose material around from the patching material. Use extra caution.
- Freshly mowed grass that has been blown onto the roads can be very slippery.

If you have new tires, use extra care for several miles (50) to wear off the "new" slickness of the tire and eliminate the mold release agent. I am planning on replacing my rear tires on our trike as they are six years old—they look good, but with the age on them they could present a problem. Tires become less flexible and more prone to blowouts as they age. That is nothing I want to deal with on a ride especially if we are riding down an interstate. It is just insurance on preventing a problem.

It is very important to check tire pressures before riding. Improperly inflated tires will not handle correctly and will greatly increase tire wear. Tires may lose up to 2 lbs. per month during the winter months.

Remember we haven't ridden for several months—use caution until we get back in synch. It may take a little time to get the handling techniques honed for the season. So, take an extra second or two to check at intersections before merging into traffic.




