Now it is time for THRIVE 2017.

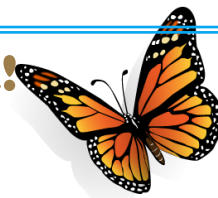

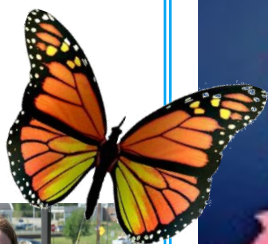

## BACKPACK MINISTRIES: DONATIONS NEEDED

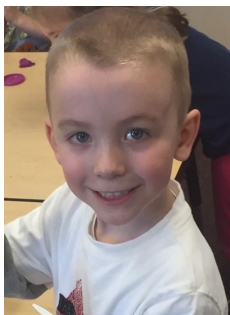
