Library Landscaping: Director Jackson had contact with Brendon Gusse this week and will have a meeting next week to discuss further plans for landscaping at the front of the library.

Parking: According to Sherrard Village ordinances the library is in the angle parking zone. Director Jackson is still trying to get agreement from the village to install angle parking on Main Street and Fifth Avenue.

Holiday Party: It was decided to have the library holiday party on December 2nd, the day of the Sherrard Christmas Walk. The library will be open the usual Saturday hours from 9-12 and have cookies and activities in the programming room from noon till two.

New Business:

Handicap Door: Accepted bid from Doors Inc. and Tri City Electric.

Fire and Security System: Accepted bid from Heartland Fire and Security. It was decided to add two extra cameras, one in the reading room and one outside the side door. Cost of the 2 extra cameras is \$255 apiece if we purchase them now rather than wait to add cameras later which would be more expensive.
