2/4 - Portrait Collage: We will cut and paste magazine images to create images after Van Gogh's portraiture.

2/18 - Painting, Kandinski Circles: We will paint circles of vibrant colors within a grid and discuss Kandinski.

3/11 - Making Mobiles, Calder: After looking at Calder's mobiles we will create simple mobiles from cut paper shapes.

3/25 - Puppet Making: We will make fun hand puppets, discuss, and encourage story telling through puppetry.

4/8 - Pointillism: Australian Aboriginal Painting will be discussed after which we will paint using cotton swabs.

4/22 - Yarn - God's Eyes: A simple exploration of weaving and creating hangings with this old craft technique.

5/6 - Papier-Mache Masks, Part 1: We will be making the form with papier-mache on balloons and looking at traditional masks. Between classes the balloons will dry and be cut in two.

5/20 - Papier-Mache Masks, Part 2: Painting the masks with acrylic paint. Each participant will finish two masks.

6/3 - Sculpey: Bake at home clay!
