

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Fostoria intends to apply for funding to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA). ODSA in collaboration with Ohio Department of Health (ODH) is awarding supplemental funds on a competitive basis to Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) program grantees. The supplemental funding is to acquire an X-Ray Fluorescence (XRF) analyzer or to re-source an XRF analyzer already owned by the grantee and/or administrator. The equipment will allow grantees to perform thorough and accurate lead risk assessments, which will help protect Ohio's children from the negative impact of exposure to lead based paint hazards.

If funded the City of Fostoria plans to purchase an XRF analyzer in the amount of \$23,000

The public hearing will be held **Tuesday September 20, 2022, at 5:00 p.m.** in City Council Chambers, 213 S. Main Street, Fostoria. The purpose of this hearing is to provide citizens with pertinent information about the Community Housing Impact and Preservation Lead Abatement Program (CHIP-LAP) Equipment Grant Program.

Citizens are encouraged to attend this meeting on September 20, 2022, to provide their input on the program.
