What do I need to bring?

- A valid ID for notarization purposes
- Individual check/money order for filing fees – no cash/no corporate or third party checks

What to expect:

- If arriving on the first or last day of filing, please be prepared to wait
- Officials will verify your eligibility to file for office
- Filing paperwork will be completed, signed, and notarized & filing fee must be paid at time of filing

Campaign Finance:

- Candidates will have 10 days after filing to submit Statement of Organization paperwork
- All candidates who file must establish a committee, whether under or over threshold – no exceptions
- It is recommended to use the state-provided campaign finance reporting software for all report filings
- If you have a previous campaign committee with our office, please be sure all information is current and accurate
