WHAT ITEMS TO BAG

All items such as food, drugs and medicines including those items in refrigerators and freezers must either be removed from the structure being fumigated or sealed in protective bags such as NYLOFUME. NYLOFUME bags are made from a special nylon polymer film. Double-bagging achieves optimum protection.

- 1. REFRIGERATOR AND FREEZER ITEMS: All items must be bagged & sealed for good protection (use a twist tie, masking tape or rubber band) and returned to the refrigerator/freezer.
- 2. PANTRY ITEMS: Any food that's in plastic or cardboard boxes (pastas, cereals, pancake mixes, candy, gum, tic-tacs, life savers, etc.) must be bagged and placed on the floor.
- 3. Other items that *need to be bagged* are vitamins, medications, prescriptions, toothpaste, toothbrushes, mouthwash or other ingested items.

WHAT ITEMS NOT TO BAG

- 1. Canned goods, plastic and glass jar containers that have not been opened do not need to be bagged.
- 2. All Cosmetics, lipsticks, deodorants, shampoos, cream rinse, perfumes and laundry soap will not require any bagging or preparation.

NOTE SULFURYL FLUORIDE is a gas, it does not adhere to surfaces, therefore there is no exposure from touching treated surfaces. There's no need of washing after the fumigation. All dishes (pots, pans, forks, spoons, etc.), clothing, linens, cosmetics, furniture, furnishings and electronics are fine. There is no preparation prior to the fumigation and no cleaning is required upon completion of the fumigation.
