Purpose of the Water Test

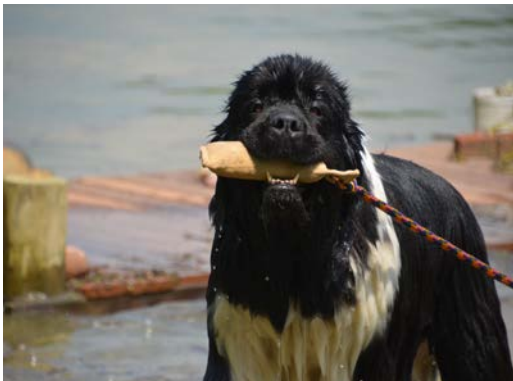
NCA Water Tests are a series of exercises designed to develop and demonstrate the abilities of purebred Newfoundland dogs in an aquatic environment. NCA water tests demonstrate natural ability and skills acquired through training, and emphasize teamwork between dog and handler in simulated work and rescue situations. The ideal working relationship is a balance of controlled performance and natural independence. Dogs should display not only efficiency in accomplishing their tasks, but also willingness and enjoyment in their work. Each exhibitor is responsible for providing his/her own water test equipment, including a U.S. Coast Guard approved personal flotation device and suitable foot protection to be worn in the water.

The Test Site

High Falls County Park is located in Seneca SC. The park is on the western shore of Lake Keowee, in Oconee County. An abundance of shore line makes this park an ideal setting. The water is very clear and together with a solid packed bottom, you should see virtually no mud, or silt disruption during the Underwater Retrieve.

The grade below the water drops off gradually and the dogs will be swimming within the required 20 feet. The water, out from the beach area, is classified as a 'No Wake Zone.'

Two clusters of pine trees offer natural shade. Entrants are encouraged to bring tarps for additional shade. Also, consider bringing a fan for your crated dog, as power will be available. as well as water. A very large pavilion will be available, restroom inside. A restroom near the entrance of the park provides a changing room and shower facilities.

From Atlanta, GA:

Take Exit #1 toward Walhalla – go 0.6 miles. Turn left on SC-11 – go 22.3 miles. Turn right on SC-24 (Country Junction Rd) – go 2.2 miles. Turn right on SC-183 (Pickens Hwy) – go 3.2 miles. Turn right on High Falls

From Asheville, NC

Take I 26 south to exit 54 for US 25 south to 11 south, to SC130 south, (left) right onto SC 183. Turn left onto High Falls Rd.

Entry Into Water Test

October 5, 2018

There are 25 entrant allotted spots

WRDX -Total of 5 entrants.

WD,WRD requalifications

If WRDX does not fill (5), the remaining spots will go toward the total spots available.

October 6, 2018

There are 25 entrant allotted spots

WD, WRD, WRD Requals

If space allows, WRD requalifiers will be given the balance after all WD and WRD entries are processed.

October 7, 2018

There are 25 entrant spots

WRDX -Total of 5 entrants. WD, WRD, WRD Requals

20 entries of WD, WRD will be accepted, with remaining spots to Re-Qualifiers. If WRDX does not fill (5), the remaining spots will go toward the total of 25 spots available.

Entry fee is \$45.00 for each dog each day.

Entries can be accepted by U.S. Postal Service and must be postmarked no earlier than August 7th, 2018 for NCA members. Any entries received with a postmark prior to August 7, 2018 will be returned to sender. Non-NCA members must be postmarked no earlier than August 17th, 2018.

Priority will be given to entrants who have not earned titles in the Division entered. Foreign entries must show a verifiable date of mailing. All entries must be submitted on entry form, include a copy of the dog's current AKC registration, & appropriate fee.

The Last accepted Postmark is 8/28/2018

After that date, entries cannot be accepted, canceled/refunded, altered, or substituted. Entries will be made according to postmark date. In the event the number of entries with the same postmark date received exceeds the limit, vacancies will be filled and alternates will be determined by a random drawing. Entries received after the entry limit has been reached will be placed on an alternate list in order of postmark. Alternates will be notified immediately should an opening occur. As space permits, re-qualifiers are welcomed. The SENC will abide by the most recent policy on Accepting and Assigning Entries and Alternates and Refunds as stated in the Newfoundland Water Dog, Water Rescue Dog, and Water Rescue Dog Excellent Regulations updated March 2018.

Per the NCA Water Test Regulations, if a dog entered in WD has passed a WD test after the closing date for entries, the entry may be transferred from the WD to the WRD Division. Dogs who earn a WRD title in a subsequent water test, and who are entered in WRD at tests whose entries have closed, may transfer their entry from the WRD to WRDX tests. To transfer the entry, the handler must submit to the Water Test Secretary a signed statement listing the name of the dog, the date and location or the Water Test passed, the judges' names, and the name and address of the owners. A change of entry from WD to WRD or WRD to WRDX must be received by Test Secretary by 6:00 pm the night before the test.

Re-Qualifiers for WRD

Entrants for re-qualifiers will be accepted only if the entry limit is not reached. Dogs that qualify in Senior at a previous test may stay in as Re-qualifiers, but will be moved to the alternate list (if any). Acceptance into the test(s) will then be based on postmark of the original entry.

Post Entries

Dogs that successfully fulfill the requirements for a Junior Division Water Dog title at a test may be post-entered into the Senior Division test and will be tested at the conclusion of Senior Division judging. The handler will be allowed to test his dog only until it fails an exercise. An additional post-entry fee of \$15.00 must be given to the Test Secretary at the site at the completion of the Junior Division.

NCA Aggression Policy

Any dog that, in the opinion of the Event Committee, attacks a person or a dog at an NCA working event, resulting in an injury, and is believed by that Event Committee to present a hazard to persons or other dogs, shall be disqualified. When the dog is disqualified by the Event Committee pursuant to this section, a report shall be filed with the NCA Board. The disqualified dog may not again compete at any NCA working event, nor be on the grounds of an NCA working event unless and until, following application for reinstatement by the owner to the NCA Board, the owner receives official notification in writing from the NCA Board that the dog's eligibility has been reinstated.

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season shall be judged on the water exercises at the conclusion of judging for that day. When Junior and Senior Division entries are judged on the same day, any Junior Division bitches in season shall be judged after other regular judging for both divisions has been completed, followed by the Senior Division bitches in season. Please inform the Test Secretary as early as possible if your bitch is in season.

Un-entered Dogs

Spectators, as well as un-entered dogs are welcome at the SENC Water Test. However, un-entered dogs will not be permitted near the test site area. As a courtesy to our exhibitors, we ask that all dogs be kept quiet, on leash or crated. The appointed Safety Officer is responsible for ensuring that all un-entered dogs are kept outside and away from the test area.

Dogs in Vehicles

No closed vehicles are allowed with dogs in them. If your dog is in your vehicle, the dog must be confined to a crate with the windows and or doors open. It is your responsibility to be sure your dog is safe, cool and has plenty of water.
