
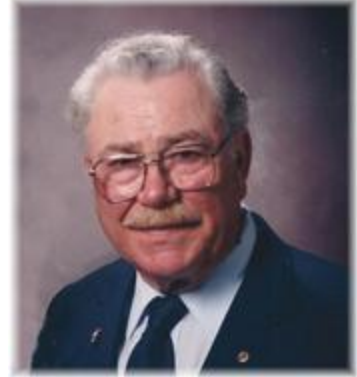


## George W. Kuhl
