2021 Election Committee Report

Below is the LTRVP Ballot Custody Process and Procedure and the final report for ballots received totaling 297. The election committee will meet on the Friday prior to the annual meeting to open the sealed envelopes and tally the votes. Candidates have been invited to observe this process but will be excused prior to the final tally. The final tally for each candidate will be shared at the annual meeting Saturday, July 24, 2021 in the pavilion at 10:00 AM. Only two (2) ballots were returned due to an invalid address.

July 15, 2021 - Message from the Board

Mosquito Spraying Clarification: The mosquito spraying/fogging will be done on Monday & Thursday nights commencing at 9:00PM (subject to conditions). The application is subject to strict guidelines. There is only one pass on the route while fogging. This is contrary to past years applications but is now compliant with the product use requirements.

<u>Dust Control</u> - The Board has been in continuous contact with Olsen's regarding servicing our park dust control needs. Olsen's is working on it but their action is subject to product availability.

River Access - A cable has been placed at B & P St. river access. This is not a deeded LEGAL ACCESS but rather an accommodation to owners that has been provided through the years. As you know, this area is the location of a sewer lift station that requires regular maintenance and unexpected repairs. It must be accessible to the backhoe, service technicians and park employees. Additionally, it could be used by emergency personnel for medical, rescue & fire issues. Recent heavy use by fun seekers resulted in ATVs, UTVs, golf carts and vehicles blocking the intended use area. A 47" wide access has been provided to accommodate pedestrians, wheelchairs, motorized handicap devices, bicycles, kayak drop-offs, etc. We regret the need to cable the area but hope you understand the need.

July 15, 2021 - Message from the Election Committee REMINDER - Only ballots received before midnight, Monday, July 19, 2021 will be included in the tally.

Candidates will be excused after all ballots are opened and before the final tally is calculated.
