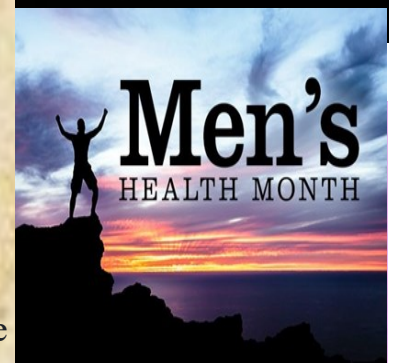

Leading Lady's Corner / Women's Ministry

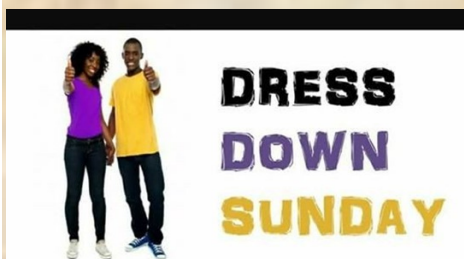


Greetings, in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

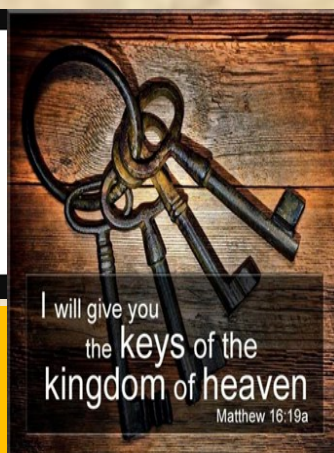
Ladies join us as we continue to explore the strategies that the enemy will use against us and how to use Fervent prayer to fight back.
