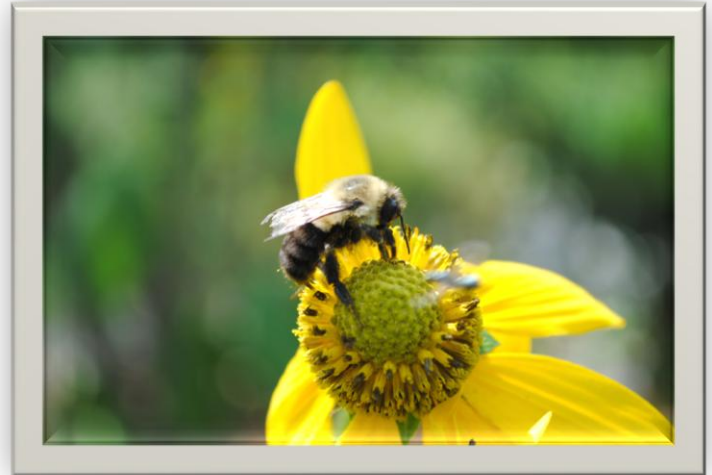


Important Pollinator Plants
