### Regular Meeting of December 17, 2012

Allan Overhiser called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm and led in the pledge of allegiance. A moment of silence was held for Judy Graff for the loss of her father. Approximately 16 people were present, along with Josiah Jessup, Trustee; Judy Graff, Trustee; Cheri Brenner, Clerk; Lu Winfrey, Treasurer; and Allan Overhiser, Supervisor.

Public Comment: David Diny questioned about the South Haven Hospital sending to many things out to the public and doesn't use recycled paper.

Judy Graff stated that this comment has not been brought up at any of the meetings.

Cheri Brenner read thank you note from Julie Cowie.

# **Water Sewer Financial Issues:**

A draft audit needs to be reviewed which will be relying on debt requirements. Casco has been sufficient in developing residential but the city is behind on theirs. There will be a joint meeting in March 2013 to discuss South Haven Chartered Township raise their debt amount. The authority will probably set an administrative fee, there hasn't been a charge before. Judy Graff asked what the mandatory hookup would be in 5yrs. Judy also mentioned that there should be a 5yr spread sheet to see where we are at right now and will be.

#### Other Business:

<u>Bike Trail:</u> It was concluded that we support the Bike Trail but we are not in the position to fund or maintain it. We already have 10 years of work to complete our projects going already.

Judy Graff read email from residents in Casco in support of the bike trail. This letter will be reference as part of the minutes.

Bruce Brandon mentioned that there are people whom want to be involved but at this time there isn't any structure.
