Misleading Finals

-Illinois crushed Northwestern 41-3. However, the Fighting Illini were out-gained 321-292 as they benefited from a +5 TO margin.
-Arizona beat Arizona St 38-35 but were out-gained 537-480. The Wildcats benefited from a +4 TO margin.
-Middle Tennessee was outgained 497-447 in their win over FIU as the Blue Raiders were +4 in TO's.
-Toledo had a 334-188 yard edge but lost 20-14 at Western Michigan (-3 in TO's).
-TCU crushed Iowa St 62-14 but were only +47 yards in the game. The Horned Frogs scored a couple of defensive TD's and were +3 in TO's.

Bad Beats

-We had an all-time bad beat last Friday in college football. Utah St was getting (+16.5 or +17). With 90 seconds left, Utah St trailed 28-23 but had the ball at the Boise St 11-yard trying to win the game outright. They threw an interception. Game over...right? Wrong! Instead of taking a knee and running out the clock (Utah St did have a timeout), Boise St got a 91-yard TD run from QB Taylen Green to make it 35-23. You were still in good shape...right? Wrong! Utah St threw a 48-yard "Pick 6" on 4th down and somehow Boise covered 42-23.
-The total in the Syracuse/Boston College game was 47. BC led 10-6 entering the 4Q. The Eagles (+10.5) actually led 17-6 with 10 minutes left but Syracuse scored 4 TD's including the final one with :35 left when they could have taken a knee. BC marched down the field and got the cover with :07 left, a cover they deserved.
-The total in the North Carolina/NC State game was 56. North Carolina scored on the final play of the game to make it 24-24. The game went OVER the total in the second overtime.

Week 14 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past six seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 421-355-12 (54%) clip! So far this season those games are 43-38-2. That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **N/A**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

CUSA Championship Game - Alamodome - San Antonio, TX

UTSA 37 North Texas 28. A rematch of a game earlier this year where UTSA won at home 31-27 as 10-point favorites (total was 73). It was a wild 4Q with UTSA outscoring North Texas 21-14. We have a couple of Top 20 offenses here but UTSA has the edge on defense with North Texas allowing 451 ypg (No. 121). Also noteworthy is that North Texas' top 2 RB's have missed the last two games. Keep an eye on their statuses. Early money is on the OVER but we haven't bet this game yet.

Pac-12 Championship Game - Allegiant Stadium - Las Vegas, NV

† **Usc 35 Utah 32.** Our numbers say Utah is the play here as the Utes are better in ypg and ppg margin despite playing a slightly tougher schedule. The earlier meeting saw Utah -3.5 at home coming away with a dramatic 43-42 win. Utah got a late 2-point conversion but note USC was up 14 most of the first half. Can Utah QB Cam Rising play anywhere close to what he did in the first game where he threw for 415 yards and ran for 60 yards and 3 TD's? That was the most passing yards by a Utah QB since 2005. Utah TE Dalton Kincaid also had 16 receptions for 234 yards, the most by a Utah TE in their history. Utah's leading rusher Tavion Thomas is out. On the other side, USC won the line of scrimmage vs Notre Dame (204-90 rushing) and won the rushing battle vs Utah (175-138) earlier this year. Caleb Williams pretty much locked up the Heisman last week and this week the Trojans can lock up a CFB Playoff berth with a win. Utah away from home vs top competition includes losses to Florida, UCLA and Oregon (0-3 ATS). This is another game where we haven't gotten to the window yet. We need a "+3.5".

BUFFALO 33 Akron 23. This is a rescheduled game from a couple of weeks ago. A lot of line now for Buffalo who needs a win to get to bowl eligibility. The Bulls are reeling from blowing a late 14-point 4Q lead in the OT loss to Kent St last week. Meanwhile, Akron is off their best performance in several years as they destroyed Northern Illinois 44-12 as 9.5-point underdogs. The Zips had a 512-261 yard edge. We bet Akron +14 on the openers but would only lean that way now.

Saturday, December 3rd

Big 12 Championship Game - AT&T Stadium - Arlington, TX

† **Tcu 31 Kansas St 29.** If TCU wins, the Horned Frogs are heading to the CFB Playoff and there's even a chance they could still get there even with a loss. This is a rematch from an earlier meeting where TCU won 38-28 as 3.5-point home favorites (total 54.5). TCU had a 495-390 edge but Kansas St had to use 3 different QB's in the game. TCU was +2 in TO's and Kansas St missed 2 FG's while blowing a 28-10 lead. The Horned Frogs are 9-2-1 ATS on season (+9.6) but Kansas St is 8-3-1 ATS as we've upgraded both teams significantly this season. Kansas St QB Will Howard is playing well (13-2 ratio) and there's a chance we could see a Adrian Martinez package for the game (QB run). On the other side, TCU WR Quentin Johnston sat out last week but should be good to go this week. Don't be fooled by that 48-point win for TCU last week. The Horned Frogs were only +47 yards! We think Kansas St is the sharper side here but need a "+3" to show in the market. We do lean UNDER.

MAC Championship Game - Ford Field - Detroit, MI

† **Toledo 29 Ohio 27.** Two teams heading in opposite directions. Ohio has covered 8 straight games while Toledo has failed to cover in 5 straight. Ohio is playing with a backup QB with Rourke out for the season while both Toledo QB's Dequan Finn and Tucker Gleason have not looked 100% in recent weeks. We are not big fans of Toledo head coach Jason Candle who does "less with more" than just about any coach in the country. The Rockets were favored in 11 games this year. They won 7. They've lost 7 times outright the last two years as a TD-plus favorites. Meanwhile, Ohio has not won a MAC title since 1968. We bet them +4.5 but can't recommend them at the current numbers.

Sun Belt Championship Game - Veterans Memorial Stadium - Troy, AL

2★ TROY 29 Coastal Carolina 18. A very interesting handicap here with the status of Coastal Carolina QB Grayson McCall in question. It now appears like he will play. We question how effective he will be even if he does play. Remember it was a foot injury and sometimes those are tough to recover from in a quick time frame. Coastal is a very overrated team as the Chanticleers have been out-gained on the season and are -0.2 ypp despite a 9-2 record. Their defense is No. 120 in yards per play allowed. Meanwhile, Troy has been a model of consistency with one of their losses this year coming via a "Hail Mary" on the final play. Had they held on vs App St, we'd be looking at a Troy team with 11 straight wins entering this contest. They have the significant defensive edge here ranking No. 8 in the country in ypp allowed. Even if McCall plays, we like Troy here.

AAC Championship Game - Yulman Stadium - New Orleans, LA

TULANE 29 Central Florida 26. A rematch of a game from November 12th where UCF won 38-31 as 1-point road underdogs (total 54.5). Since that game though, UCF is 0-2 ATS failing to cover by a combined 31 points while Tulane is 2-0 ATS covering by a combined 33.5 points. In addition, UCF QB John Rhys Plumlee is a little banged up so that's why this line sits at Tulane -3.5. Tulane also got good news in that head coach Willie Fritz looks like he will be staying as he was a leading candidate for the Georgia Tech job. We laid -2.5 on Sunday but are not racing to lay 3.5 now. **Mountain West Championship Game - Albertson's Stadium - Boise, ID**
BOISE ST 27 Fresno St 24. Another conference championship game with another rematch here. Boise won the earlier meeting 40-20 as 10.5-point home favorites (total 45). Fresno St has won 7 straight games since then. Remember, they are a completely different team with QB Jake Haener in the line-up and he didn't play in the first meeting. We bet Fresno +4.5 on the openers and anything above "3" is worth a bet. Obviously, Boise St had a very fortunate cover last week vs Utah St and make sure to check the injury report as the Broncos were missing several starters.

SEC Championship Game - Mercedes-Benz Stadium - Atlanta, GA

† **Georgia 33 Lsu 17.** Before betting this game, you need to get clarification on the health status of LSU QB Jayden Daniels. He was in a walking boot earlier this week after getting hurt very late in the Texas A&M game. Daniels also is the team's leading rusher and it is a foot injury. LSU's offensive line has allowed 41 sacks this year even with a mobile QB and will be up against it here vs a Georgia defense that is allowing just 80 rushing ypg. Diving through LSU's schedule and stats, this looks more like a 8-4/7-5 team than one playing for a SEC title. Meanwhile, Georgia ranks No. 1 in ypp margin and ypp margin. They're not as good as last year's team but they are still the best team in the country in 2022. What's their motivation for margin though as the Bulldogs have bigger fish to fry down the road.

SWAC Championship Game - Miss Veterans Stadium - Jackson, MS

JACKSON ST 34 Southern 16. We normally don't cover FCS games but there is a line out at several books as we go to press so we will include it. This is a rematch from an earlier meeting that saw Jackson St win 35-0 (+141 yards) as 17.5-point home favorites (total 56.5). Jackson St is +28 ppg and +234 ypg on the season while Southern is +12 ppg and +108 ypg on the season. Southern is off the big rivalry win over Grambling last week (Jackson St had a bye). We bet Jackson St -16.5 but there are concerns that head coach Deion Sanders is gone after this game.

ACC Championship Game - Bank of America Stadium - Charlotte, NC

† **Clemson 35 North Carolina 26.** Both teams limp into this matchup. Clemson saw their 40-game home winning streak come to an end last week as they lost outright to rival South Carolina as 14-point favorites. Meanwhile, North Carolina lost in 2OT to rival NC State. That's two straight losses for the Tar Heels as favorites. NC QB Drake Maye looks like he is running on fumes. He had 6 straight games of 50-plus rush yards and now just 13 and 32 the last two weeks. Also Maye is 45 of 79 (57%) with a 1-2 ratio and just 435 passing yards the last two weeks. However, Clemson QB DJ Uiagalelei's confidence has to be completely gone after going just 8 of 29 for 99 yards last week. Which coach and team do you trust to bounce back? We will be involved on Clemson if this line ever goes to -7.

Big Ten Championship Game - Lucas Oil Stadium - Indianapolis, IN

† **Michigan 34 Purdue 18.** Michigan was clearly the right side last week as we unfortunately got our butts kicked on these pages taking the Buckeyes. Michigan finally showed some explosiveness in the pass game and had a total of 5 TD's that traveled at least 45 yards. Meanwhile, Purdue is making their first Big Ten Championship game appearance. The Boilers are obviously at a big disadvantage with Michigan No. 4 in ypp margin (Purdue No. 71). Also Purdue's pass game is averaging just 214 ypg the last 4 weeks and the offense overall just 330 ypg. Purdue QB Aidan O'Connell will start but he's missed practice time this week due to a personal matter. What is Michigan's motivation for margin here? They're likely in the playoffs even with a loss. Also does RB Corum play here... we have our doubts.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, December 1st

Buffalo 23 NEW ENGLAND 20. Both teams have a full week of prep as both played on Thanksgiving. Buffalo QB Josh Allen does not look 100% and will be facing a Patriots' defense that ranks No. 2 in DVOA. The Bills are just 1-4 ATS in their last 5 games after the big win at Kansas City. Their only cover in that stretch was by a 0.5-point to Cleveland. Meanwhile, New England might be a little under-valued (6-2 ATS last 8) and last week had a 7.4-5.4 ypp edge but a kickoff return TD really hurt them in the loss vs Minnesota. We lean with the Patriots here.

Sunday, December 4th

MINNESOTA 23 N.Y. Jets 22. Even at 9-2, we still think the Vikings are overrated. They are -0.8 in ypp margin (No. 28) and rank only No. 22 in DVOA. They play a rejuvenated Jets team that crushed Chicago last week. The Jets have played the more difficult schedule (No. 5 vs No. 16 in Sagarin) and yet are No. 7 in ypp margin. Mike White looked like an upgrade over Zach Wilson. We lean with the Jets here.

BALTIMORE 23 Denver 14. You have to question what the Denver locker-room is like now as we've seen public displays of frustration on the sidelines. The Broncos are 3-8 ATS as their offense has failed to reach 17 points in 9 of their 11 games! Meanwhile, Baltimore suffered another upset loss this time to Jacksonville. Statistically, the Ravens look the part as they rank No. 2 in DVOA. The problem is they're wildly inconsistent. We expect the Ravens to get back on track here. But we're not laying the 9 points. Totals' players note the UNDER is 10-1 in Denver games this year.

ATLANTA 21 Pittsburgh 20. Pittsburgh comes in on a short week after the MNF win over Indianapolis. Meanwhile, Atlanta is 1-5 ATS in their last 6 games and their 6-0 ATS start. Pittsburgh has played the much tougher schedule (No. 1 vs No. 27) and looks like they are starting to gain some confidence. Too tough to call.

2★ TEN (plus the points) PHILADELPHIA 24 Tennessee 21. Obviously, the Eagles have good stats being 10-1 SU (No. 4 in ypp margin) but they have benefited from playing a very soft schedule (No. 31). Tennessee failed to cover for the first time since Week 2 last week in the 20-16 loss to Cincinnati. Tough to get margin on a team that likes to run and is solid defensively. We like Tennessee.

DETROIT 26 Philadelphia 25. A lot of early money has come in on Jacksonville in this game. The Jags upset the Ravens last week and are better in ypp margin (-0.1 vs -0.5). Meanwhile, the Lions have extra rest after the valiant effort in the close loss to the Bills on Thanksgiving. The Lions have covered 4 games in a row while the Jags are 0-3 SU and ATS as a favorite this year. We disagree with the early money.

Washington 21 N.Y. GIANTS 19. Obviously, the Commanders are playing their best ball of the season with a 6-0-1 ATS mark in their last 7 games. This is the 13th straight week for them though. Meanwhile, the Giants are really banged up on the OL and in the secondary. We continue to feel they are overrated as they ranked No. 26 in ypp margin despite playing a very weak schedule. However, the market is all over this as fading the G-Men does not come with a discount. We're passing.

Cleveland 27 HOUSTON 20. Deshaun Watson is back after a 2-year layoff and he faces his former team. The Browns come in off their upset of Tampa Bay in OT last week (much to our dismay on these pages). Despite a 4-7 record, Cleveland ranks No. 14 in DVOA and are No. 19 in ypp margin despite playing a tough schedule. We do expect rust though from Watson. Meanwhile, Houston is clearly the worst team in the league.

Green Bay 24 CHICAGO 20. As of press-time there is a lot of uncertainty in this one with both teams dealing with QB injuries. With the Packers favored by 4.5 though, you'd have to think Aaron Rodgers will play. The Packers have covered just 2 of their last 9 games while the Bears looked abysmal with Trevor Siemian. Justin Fields remains limited and Siemian now is missing practice time. We don't have much interest.

Seattle 24 L.A. RAMS 16. The Rams are well on their way to becoming the worst defending Super Bowl champion ever. Their point differential is already the worst ever and it's only getting worse from this point forward. They rank dead last in offensive ypp. Meanwhile, Seattle should be plenty angry after blowing the game vs Las Vegas last week in OT. Seattle in a teaser down to 1.5 makes a lot of sense.

2★ SAN FRANCISCO 27 Miami 21. This is a really good matchup as both teams are playing their best ball of the season. Miami has won 5 straight while San Francisco has won 4 straight. The 49ers rank No. 1 in ypp margin while Miami ranks No. 5. The Dolphins have played the much tougher schedule. Obviously, you have teacher vs pupil here in Shanahan vs McDaniel. We prefer to side with teacher.

LAS VEGAS 27 L.A. Chargers 26. The Raiders might have turned their season around with back-to-back OT wins on the road. The Raiders have the better ypp margin (No. 15 vs No. 28). Both teams have seen 8 of their 11 games this season decided by 7 points or less. That makes Las Vegas an attractive teaser option up to "+7.5".

Kansas City 28 CINCINNATI 26. A rematch of the AFC Championship game that saw KC blow the big lead. Both teams are playing their best ball of the season. The Bengals are on a 8-1 ATS run while Kansas City has won 5 straight games since losing to Buffalo. KC is +1.2 in ypp margin (tied for No. 1) and will be playing with revenge. This is too close to call as we'd lean with Cincinnati in a teaser and also the OVER.

DALLAS 26 Indianapolis 15. The Colts are on a short week after losing to Pittsburgh on MNF. They have decent stats (No. 15 in ypp margin) but do rank No. 30 in DVOA as the Colts offense continues to struggle. That's not good news facing the Dallas defense that ranks No. 1 in DVOA. On top of that, Dallas has extra time to prep after playing on Thanksgiving. Slight lean UNDER.

Monday, December 5th

TAMPA BAY 22 New Orleans 17. Both teams have failed to live up to expectations this season. Tampa is now on a 1-7-1 ATS run after blowing the 4Q lead in Cleveland last week. Meanwhile, the Saints are playing a 13th straight week and are just 4-8 SU/ATS. While the Saints are No. 7 in ypp margin, they rank No. 25 in DVOA and are off a shutout loss (first since 2001). Tampa Bay meanwhile ranks No. 10 in DVOA as their defense remains a Top 10 unit by most metrics. We lean Tampa and UNDER.
