What does a team look like?

A team consists of any number of students between three and ten students.

- No fewer than three
- No more than ten

<u>Team Captain:</u> responsible for settling all differences of opinion among teammates answers to provide the team's final answer.

<u>Team Scorekeeper:</u> keeps track of the teams score for each quarter using the provided scores sheets.

- There is no public speaking
- Students do not talk into any microphones
- It is not like jeopardy where the first/quickest team to respond with the correct answer gets the points
- All teams have the ability to answer correctly and earn points for every question
- It is not a competition for everyone, you must be in CBI to qualify.
