RECITAL INFORMATION

Location: Kent Roosevelt High School Auditorium Date: Saturday, June 17

RECITAL TICKETS:

Go on sale in our office Monday, May 15. It is assigned seating so the earlier you buy, the better seats you will get.

\$14.00 per ticket (for one show) / \$20.00 per ticket (for both shows)

* Most kids are only involved with one show. If they are a company dancer and perform in both shows, all of their routines will also be in the later show so if only attending one show, parents of the older company dancers are encouraged to buy a ticket for the later show.

* If buying a combined ticket for both shows, you will have the same seats.

Free – Ages 2 and under (must sit on lap)

Free – Dancers sitting in the audience (You must have a student ticket to get into the first show and second show if sitting in the audience).

Solo recital is free to all and open seating. You do not need tickets for this show.

To buy tickets, you can pay with cash, check or credit. No refunds on tickets and no changing seats once purchased.

AWARDS:

There will be a short awards ceremony after finale for each show. If this is your 5th year, 10th year or over 10th year, please sign up in the office no later than May 15.

VIDEOGRAPHY:

We will have the same videographer who did our Holiday recital. DVD order forms will be available at both the dress rehearsal and recital at the concession stand. There will be no videography for the solo recital. There will be a separate DVD for show 1 and show 2 and they are \$25.00 each show. If you would like to video yourself, we just ask that you go in the back in between the balcony and first row of floor seating so as not to distract the audience.

PROGRAM PATRONS:

Program Patrons are now on sale. You can get the forms in our office or on our website. They must be turned in by May 11.

a. Each student participating in the year end recital in June is required to sell or pay \$25.00. If there are 2 students in one family then they are required to sell / pay \$50.00, etc....

b. What do they cover - Cost of the rental of the auditorium, extra insurance, trophies, props, scenery, programs, extra costumes, etc...

c. Program Patrons - You have the option to just pay the fee or you can sell program patrons to earn the money. We have personal patrons which are \$5 each and are little messages to your child from family and friends wishing them luck in the program. Secondly we have business patrons which are \$25.00 and the business puts a business card in our program to advertise. We begin patrons in April. If you would like to see what patrons are, ask to see an old program in the office.

d. - Incentives - The family that sells the highest dollar amount of patrons receives 4 free tickets to the recital and June or Summer tuition free (your choice). Second place wins 4 free tickets to recital and third place wins 2 free tickets to recital.

FIRST SHOW:

1:00 – 2:45 p.m.

Doors open to the school and auditorium 12:30 p.m.

Tickets for first show required and it is assigned seating.

- 1. All students in this show aside from Teen and Sr Company dancers will sit in the audience with their parents.
- 2. If you are a teen or sr company dancer you must remain in the scene shop for the entire show. Please make sure you are checked in by 12:45 p.m.
- 3. Parents are responsible for dressing their child. Dressing rooms are located behind the stage in the scene shop. Boys can change in the boys bathroom located next to the scene shop in the hallway.
- 4. Please make sure your child is dropped off backstage 3 numbers before they perform (no more than 3 as it gets too congested backstage).
- 5. Please pick up your child backstage as soon as they are done dancing. Our teachers will be holding them backstage until a parent comes back to pick them up.
- 6. When siting in the audience, please make sure your child has a cover up over their costume and is sitting quietly. No running in the aisles or near the front of the stage.
- 7. No flash photography as it distracts both the dancers and the audience members.
- 8. Please wait until in between numbers to enter or exit the auditorium. Our Ushers will not let people in while there is a dance performing on stage.
- 9. Once Finale is done, we will have a short awards ceremony. All of the kids will remain on stage for this. When done, curtains will close and parents can pick up their children backstage.

SOLO SHOW:

3:15 – 4:45 p.m.

No assigned seating and no tickets required.

Students in this show may watch in the auditorium. Please make sure you are backstage 3 numbers before you perform.

SECOND SHOW:

5:30 – 8:00 p.m.

Doors open to the auditorium 5:15 p.m.

Tickets required for second show and it is assigned seating

- 1. All students in this show (aside from boys hip-hop) will be required to stay in the scene shop (located behind the stage) for the entire show. Please check in by 5:15 p.m.
 - Boys Hip-Hop, please make sure to get your free student ticket so you can sit in the audience with your family. You will come backstage at intermission.
 - No parents in the scene shop. We have all of our teachers in the scene shop to assist with any hair or costume changes. We encourage parents to enjoy the show from the audience. This show will be a little more formal than the first show.
- 2. Please make sure your dancer has all their costumes, pieces and parts when dropping off.
- 3. If you are a company dancer, it is recommended to have a laundry basket for them to put all of their costumes and accessories in so as not to lose anything with Nationals coming up. We also recommend going through their costumes and accessories after the show before leaving to

make sure nothing is missing or left behind. At intermission if you want to empty their laundry basket and put stuff away you can. We just ask that all parents leave the scene shop area before intermission is over.

- 4. When in Scene shop we will have all of our teachers present but please be courteous to your fellow dancers and keep calm and quiet. Feel free to bring snacks, drinks, Tablets, phones, etc... to keep busy if you have some down time. Parents can also drop off concessions at intermission.
- 5. Once Finale is done, we will have a short awards ceremony. All of the kids will remain on stage for this.
- 6. No flash photography as it distracts both the dancers and the audience members.
- 7. Please wait until in between numbers to enter or exit the auditorium. Our Ushers will not let people in while there is a dance performing on stage.
