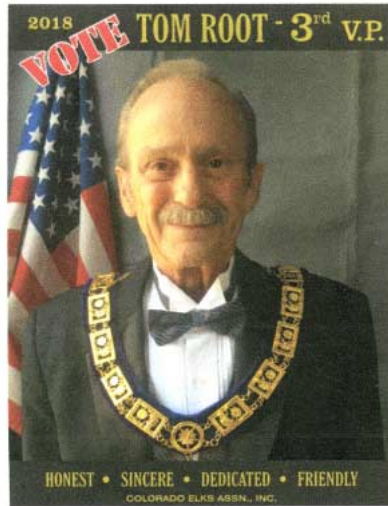
# RAYMOND THOMAS ‘TOM’ ROOT, CNW PDDGER CANDIDATE FOR 3rd VICE PRESIDENT OF THE COLORADO ELKS ASSN., INC. – 2018-2019

I was initiated into the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks in December 1980 at the Delta Elks Lodge #1235 and served as an officer every year I was a member. Due to an employment change I transferred to Lakewood #1777 in 1986, and served as Exalted Ruler in 1990–1991. In December of 2000 I transferred to Westminster Elks Lodge #2227 where I have served on many committees. In 2001 I became the Organist and served until 2016. I am the guest Organist for Arvada Lodge #2278 and have been for the past three years. I am also a Ritual Coach for the Officers.

I have been President for the PER Association of Westminster #2227 a couple of times and Secretary for many years. During my 38 years of ELKDOM I have served the Colorado Elks Association in the capacity of either a District or State chairman since 1984.

I have served as the State Chairman of the Elks National Foundation for 28 years helping to meet the per-member giving goal of the Grand Exalted Ruler for 22 years straight. I am still the State Chairman for 2017-2018.

I served as the DDGER of the CNW District in 2005-2006. I am an active contributing member of the Elks National Foundation and have reached the Silver level of giving by donating more than \$10,000.00. I started the Central Northwest District Workshop when I was Exalted Ruler and served as its first President. I am still active in the Workshop as an advisor. Through this workshop I have formed the annual District Initiation, the monthly District Lodges visitation, the annual District Flag Day ceremony with all Lodges participating, and the District Hospitality room for the Colorado



Elks conventions. I re-instituted the Central Northwest District PER Association in 1991 and this association continued until its dissolution in 2016.

I served as President, Secretary and Treasurer several times. I served one year as the President of the Colorado Elks PER Association. I have been a qualified Word Judge and Computer Judge since 1991 and became a Certified Ritual Floor Judge in 1993. I have been either the head

coach or part of the coaching team since 1991. I was honored as the Colorado Elks ‘Coach of the Year’ for 1998, 2000, 2001, 2007, 2010, 2011, 2014 and 2015.

I have attended the Colorado Elks quarterly and State conventions on a regular basis and have missed only 3 quarterly conventions since 1981. I have attended the Grand Lodge session 16 times. I have served the Colorado Elks Association, Inc. in an appointed position as the State Chaplain three times and currently am the State Organist.
