Marine Environmental Investigations - Mordialloc Creek

Australasian Marine Associates (AMA) has been involved in a number of marine environmental investigations for dredging and marine infrastructure works in Mordialloc Creek. These works include dredge material characterisation for the the Mordialloc Yacht Club and the Mordialloc Creek Boat Ramp and more recently a Marine Habitat Survey for a floating pontoon structure.

AMA were commissioned to complete the Sediment, Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP) implementation reports for the Yacht Club and the boat ramp.

The objectives for these SAP projects included:

- To implement a SAP, which considers the sampling approach specified in the NAGD (Commonwealth of Australia, 2009);
- Test and analyse sediments;
- Provide a comparison of sediment concentrations against the NAGD Screening Levels; and
- Determine the most suitability disposal method for sediment.

The Marine Habitat Survey work included a diver video transect survey within the project footprint as well as within adjacent areas. AMA are currently in the process of preparing the Marine and Coastal Act consent on behalf of our client. This includes environmental management measures to protect the receiving environment.
