

Instructions: Noun Sorting Cards

1. Print out **2 sets** of the Sorting Cards, 1 set of Title Cards, and 1 Control Chart.



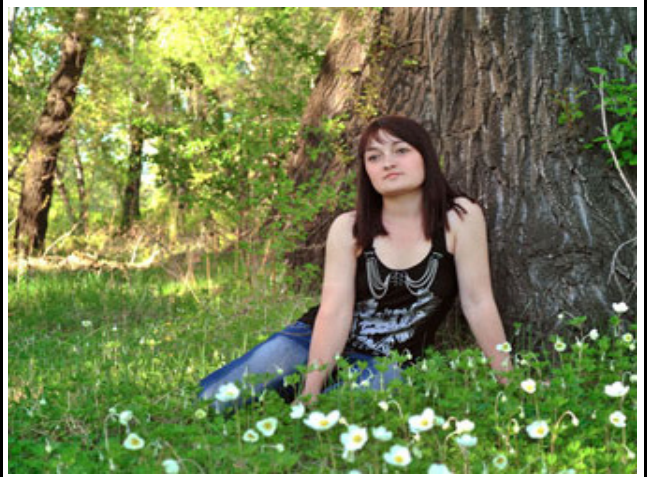
2. Cut the cards along the solid lines; leave the labels on the first set of cards attached and separate the labels from the second set.



3. Follow these directions for preparation & lamination: http://www.montessoriprintshop.com/Prepare_3-Part_Cards.html
4. Use the cards with the labels attached to confirm the child is able to read the labels correctly.
5. Use the cards without the labels and the separated labels: read the labels & match to the correct picture cards.
6. Demonstrate how to check the matching of the cards and labels by using the labelled cards to confirm.
7. Explain to the children that Nouns are divided into 3 groups: People, Places, and Things.
8. Discuss examples of each group and lay out the 3 Title Cards.
9. Using the cards with the set of labels attached; sort the cards under the correct Title Cards.
10. After the Sorting Cards have been placed under the Title Cards you can show the child how to check the sorting using the Control Chart.
11. Once the children understand how to divide the cards under the correct categories they can then create their own list or picture chart of Nouns. If a child is not yet writing with pencil & paper, they can use the Moveable Alphabet to create their list. Old magazines and newspapers usually have plenty of pictures that can be used to create a Picture Chart – or pictures can be hand drawn.
