





QUARTER SUNDAY UPDATE

I thought I'd take this opportunity, since we've reached a milestone to share a little about the history of this successful fundraising effort you continue to support here at Immanuel. I initially gave my "Quarter Sunday" suggestion to Council in late 1999. It was accepted and started in March, 2000. On the first Sunday of each month, quarters can be placed in the collection plate during the offering, then they are counted and rolled by Lori and I, after the service, in the presence of the counting team. Since the church is happy to accept any cash or coin amount folks are able to offer, only the quarters are counted for this special Quarter Sunday tally – other "loose" cash or coins are counted as "Loose" offering.

Amazing as it seems - so far, we have collected,drum-roll please....\$10,046.42. To the best of my knowledge, all the money is used here at Immanuel and has in the past been designated for special church activities like the Youth Mission Trip or Confir-camp. One idea, one voice, one quarter, can add up to be a big help in many ways with God's help and guidance. Sincere thanks to all who contribute!


