CAR CLUB COOKIES Juanita Klopfenstein

Ingredients:

- 2 Cups Flour
- 2 Cups Brown Sugar
- 2 Eggs
- 1 Cup Soft Butter
- 1 Teaspoon Baking Soda
- 1 Teaspoon Baking Powder
- ½ Teaspoon Salt
- 1 Teaspoon Vanilla
- 1 Cup Coconut (shredded)
- 1 Cup Pecans (Finely Chopped)
- 1/2 Cup Raisins
- 1/2 Cup Craisins
- 4 Cups Honey Bunches of Oats Cereal



1) Sift Together:

Flour

Baking Powder

Baking Soda

Salt

2) In Large Mixing Bowl:

Cream the Butter and Sugar until light & fluffy. Mix in Eggs & Vanilla

3) Add:

Dry Ingredients & continue mixing.

4) Stir in (by hand):

Raisins & Craisins

Bake @ 350 degrees for 12 minutes or until done. Makes approx. 3-4 dozen cookies


