We have twelve new members. Thank you Donna Daly for taking care of this for us. I really appreciate it and thank you for all you do.



The very next year, Emily wanted to give back by collecting 20 new toys with her grandfather and delivering them to the very hospital she was in, just the year before. The rest is history!






