APPLICATION PROCESS

- CNA Application (\$10.00 application fee)
- Applicant must be at least 17 years of age
- Provide Next-Generation Accuplacer sentence skills test score
- Immunization records (2 MMR vaccines)
- CPR (for Health Care Providers)-optional
- TB Skin test
- Influenza vaccine
- 1 work or personal reference

After successfully completing the Certified Nursing Assistant program, each applicant is eligible to apply for LPN program.

FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid is not available for the Certified Nursing Assistant Program. The programs cost is estimated at \$540.00. This includes tuition and books. The certification cost is \$85.00.
