
Save the Dates for our 20th Anniversary Celebrations



Additionally, the Museum will be launching a new educational series, posting live videos each weekday at 10am CT geared towards kids and families on their Facebook page and YouTube.

In the week prior to the closure, several people took delivery of their new Corvette C8s, among them the NCM Board President Glenn Johnson and his wife Andrea who chose a Torch Red Coupe. "Drives like a dream" said Andrea.



MICHELIN NCM BASH MOVED TO MAY

Due to the widespread COVID-19 virus, the Michelin NCM Bash has been moved from April 23-25 **to May 28-30** inclusive. The Bash is still the event season opener with several configurations of the new 2020 Corvette expected to be on display! The 2020 Bash will also feature the Entombed Corvette exhibit, book signings, guided road tours, two celebrity choice car shows, a celebrity autograph session, live auction, the Ladies' Oasis, and the Ladies Garage with women of the Corvette Team. Online registration is open: Lifetime members \$20pp, member registration is \$25pp and non-member registration is \$35pp. With the change of date, there could be openings for some of the road trips and other events taking place during the Bash. BOWLING GREEN CORVETTE ASSEMBLY PLANT CLOSED

General Motors has closed all assembly plants worldwide effective March 20th to deep clean and sanitize the plants and to stop the spread of the virus. Production of the 2020 Corvette C8s has been halted until at least March 30. Production status will be reevaluated week-to-week after that.

According to Corvette Blogger (March 20/20), shipping of the new 2020 Corvettes will continue despite the plant's temporary two-week shut-down! Many GM dealerships remain open here and in the US, so, if you're one of the lucky people who ordered a C8, you *just might*



receive your new Corvette in the near future. The first C8s to arrive in Canada landed at Finch



Chevrolet in London on March 6th in the darkness of night. The colour of the C8 in the photo (previous page) is *Ceramic Matrix Gray Metallic.*

2020 NCM LE MANS VIEWING PARTY, SEPTEMBER 19-20, 2020



Entries have been announced for the 88th 24 Hours of Le Mans, and as usual, Corvette Racing has once again been invited to participate. The midengine Corvette C8.R race car makes its Le Mans debut this year and driving the No. 63 Corvette will be regulars Antonio Garcia and Jordan Taylor, with their endurance racing teammate, Nicky Catsburg. Longtime teammates Tommy Milner and Oliver Gavin will share the No. 64 C8.R at Le Mans with Marcel Fässler. **But**, it will not be run in June as usual. Rather, the new date will be September 19-20.

The 2020 racing season, for all series everywhere, has been drastically changed due to the worldwide pandemic that we're all living through. Races for Corvette originally scheduled for March and early May have been rescheduled to dates later in the year. Long Beach, originally scheduled for April 17-18, has been cancelled outright. At the time of writing this and according to IMSA, the season for Corvette "may" recommence with the June 25-28 Watkins Glen race.

Here are the teams' amended race dates as published on March 24th:

June 25-28: Six Hours of The Glen July 3-5: CTMP July 17-18: Lime Rock Park July 31–Aug. 2: Road America Aug. 21-23: Virginia International Raceway Sept. 4-6: Laguna Seca Sept. 25-27: Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course Oct. 14-17: Petit Le Mans Nov. 11-14: Twelve Hours of Sebring

The schedule is the same from late June to end of August as it is every year. But as it now stands, the team will be *very, very* busy in September, with overseas travel thrown in.

Before racing and testing were cancelled in March, Corvette Racing used the Sebring track for two days in February for major testing of the C8.R. All six drivers participated and provided input re tire pressures and suspension set-ups for example...all toward making the car better whenever racing resumes and for the drivers to more fully "feel" the car and understand it's potential.

Remember that Sebring 1000 Miles FIA-WEC race, set for March 20th at Sebring? Well, it was cancelled too, due to travel restrictions amid the virus pandemic, denying Mike Rockenfeller and Jan Magnussen the chance to drive a Corvette C8.R. There is no make-up date for this race.

In other racing news and for those interested in the **Victoria Day Speed-Fest** at CTMP, word will be provided in the near future by the sanctioning body, SRO World Challenge, as to whether the weekend will go ahead or be rescheduled.

No word on CTMP Vintage Racing either.


