Willoughby Outdoor Market

To Market, To Market One more month left to savor Fresh and Local produce Alive with flavor!

You may think that when summer is over so are the farmers markets but the good news is.....they're The Willoughby Outdoor Market runs through the last Saturday in October, rain or shine. Your local growers planted crops several months ago in order to have produce to bring to market these remaining weeks. What can I find at market this time of year, you ask?

Bushels of winter squashes like butternut, acorn, and spaghetti squash. Bags and bunches of cool weather greens like lettuce, spinach, chard, kale and collards. Brussels sprouts, broccoli, cauliflower, and cabbage. Turnips, beets, carrots!. Garlic and onions!. Potatoes of all sizes and colors. Apples and pears.

As an added bonus, except for the tender greens, everything listed can be kept in a cool, dry place for several months after market has Shop the market during October then continue to enjoy fresh and local vegetables through the end of the year and beyond!

Let's have a closer look at a fall crop that comes in all shapes and sizes, a class of vegetables called winter squash. Belonging to the same family as pumpkins, these squashes also have hard skins. The yellow-orange flesh inside has a sweet potato-like flavor plus roastable seeds inside. Two treats in one!

But I don't know what to do with winter squash, you say? Have no fear! You've carved at least one pumpkin in your life, right? Winter squashes are faster and easier to open up and get cooking! There are many ways to enjoy winter squashes and most begin with this very basic cooking method.

Cut the squash in half long-ways (a helpful tip for cutting through the hard shell is to cut off the ends first to make a flat, stable base and expose the softer insides), scoop out the seeds which can be saved for roasting just like pumpkin seeds, then roast the squash in the oven until the flesh is soft enough to mash, 45-60 minutes depending on the size. From there you can elaborate by adding flavors with butter or coconut oil, honey or maple syrup, and seasonings like cinnamon, nutmeg, cumin, rosemary and other herbs you fancy before roasting.

Kind of like a potato; once you master the basic cooking technique you can change up the flavors in any way you like. Sweet or savory. Spicy or herby. Another approach is to cut off the ends and peel the

squash. This works well on smooth ones like Butternut, not as well on ribbed ones like Acorn. Then cut in half, remove seeds, and chop into small pieces before roasting or simmering for soups and stews. Of course, there are an infinite number of recipes online but ask the squash grower at market too. Make this the year you venture into the flavorful and healthful world of squash!

Market administrators advise the following for shoppers: If you are sick, please stay home!

- When possible, order directly from farmers and food producers for delivery or pick-up.

is our purchase of a new squad for our fire department and three police cruisers for our police department. These purchases require encumbering funds by mid-October and receiving these vehicles before the end of December. Considering a squad may take over a year to order, build, and equip before entering service, and a police cruiser at least six months, the speed and care used in obtaining these vehicles is impressive. Without the CARES Act, it was doubtful if any capital purchases, beyond dispatch center improvements, could have been

made this year.

As the pandemic lingers, it is important to note that Lake County has done a remarkable job in managing this health crisis. New cases in Lake County, which had brief spikes in April, May, July and September have otherwise been steady, and we have avoided a surge that may have overwhelmed our local hospitals. As of mid-September, and since reporting began, there have been slightly over 1,400 hundred positive cases in Lake County and about 250 positive cases in Willoughby. Overall, we have done a great job of working through this challenging pandemic.

Development activity in our City is witnessing a significant upswing with the proposal of some exciting projects. We hear that Willoughby is a highly desirable place to live, and over the next few months, several residential proposals will be advanced. The administration and City Council recognize that our residents would like to learn about these projects and have a voice in their reviews. The pandemic presents challenges to the traditional public participation process of large meetings, and we are evaluating how we can best communicate with constituents.

We will announce these meetings on our website and Facebook page once confirmed.

Finally, thank you for your continued support of services firms, professional merchants and bars and restaurants, all of which have faced incredible hardships during the pandemic. Compliance with State and Lake County Health District guidelines have been difficult, and some are struggling for survival. Many of these businesses are owned or operated by our neighbors or friends, and we encourage our residents to continue to support local enterprises whenever possible.

Bankruptcy 101:

Overcoming the Fear of Filing Bankruptcy

Filing bankruptcy is scary on many fronts. I know because I'm a bankruptcy lawyer and I talk to bankruptcy clients every day. I also have had financial problems like most everyone else and I was scared at the time. I thought about filing bankruptcy. I must admit it was a very frightening thought. I really believed that my life for all practical purposes would end in humiliation and despair. I believed that everyone would look at me and talk and snicker. That it would be in the newspapers and my parents would disown me and that I would die lonely because no one would ever speak to me again. Forget about ever getting another date. They probably wouldn't even let me adopt a

At that time, I couldn't put my finger on why the thought of filing Bankruptcy was so HORRIFYING. Since that time, I have had the opportunity to speak with many people who have gone through the bankruptcy process now I know why the idea of bankruptcy is so scary. I also know now why it is such an irony that the solution to so many scary things causes us such apprehension. The reason is simple. It is an assault on our pride. A blow to our ego. There is no other reason to fear such a remarkably effective solution to real tragedy (like, say, having your wages garnished, being sued, losing your home, not having money to eat, dying from stress, going insane, etc.) Pride is one of the seven deadly sins because it causes us to do things that we should not. It also causes us NOT TO DO THINGS THAT WE SHOULD.

Based on my conversations with many people I have concluded that bankruptcy is looked at in the negative. I know people are reading this last line and thinking "duh-yeah!" But in my world, I don't think it is so straight forward. Because I see fearful, distressed, sad, stressed out, suicidal, miserable,

guilt ridden, angry people made better by bankruptcy. Not just a little better, either. A lot better. The "I can't believe it, but I actually have peace of mind!" kind of better. I run into people at the grocery store who tell me life has never been so good. I wouldn't normally believe them because I knew them. They were our clients. They were people who came into our office eight months earlier depressed, hopeless, despondent, fearful and beaten. But now their faces, their demeanor and their attitudes are hardly recognizable. They have been restored to sanity. They have been healed and they know peace. That past life that was so unmanageable, painful and, seemingly, spiraling downward out of control did not crash and burn. Something took the controls and managed to pull it back up seconds before the fiery fateful collision- moments before they came to that dark place that is not known but dreaded. That something was the law of Bankruptcy!

It was probably something greater that took them to the acceptance that bankruptcy was the only thing that could right their lives at this point. But that is beyond this discussion. Everybody's bottom is at a different level. The only question is how much suffering a person endures and makes their family endure until they embrace the solution. I am a simple man. I think financial problems have a simple solution. That solution is bankruptcy.

So, no, you are not a loser if you need bankruptcy and use it. You will be a winner. Trust me, I know. We are not dealing with kids or irresponsible adults who went crazy at the mall and want to skate out of debt. Not in this world. Not now. In these times, people are struggling to eat; to drive to work; to live. And, no, you are not the only one who is in this much financial trouble. You only think you are because they don't make television sitcoms about the pretty people living in California hanging out at the beach filling out their bankruptcy petition. YOUR





Where are the holes in Medicare?

Medicare is a lot like Swiss face a major medical event. There are ways to plug these holes, but first let's look at some areas where Medicare beneficiaries will pay out-of-pocket if their only coverage is Original Medicare Parts A & B.

While Medicare Part A covers hospital stays, Medicare beneficiaries are responsible for deductibles and copayments. These costs are listed in detail at

Medicare Part B

Original Medicare does not automatically cover prescription drugs. Beneficiaries need to purchase a separate Medicare Part D prescription drug plan to get this coverage.

Annual cap

Unlike Medicare Advantage plans, Original Medicare does not cap your annual out-of-pocket share of medical costs. If you experience an extended stay in the hospital, these costs will add up very quickly.

Here are some other items and services Original Medicare does not cover:

- Routine dental care and dentures
- Routine eye exams and prescription lenses

- · Hearing aids and exams for fitting them
- Routine foot care
 - Acupuncture
 - Cosmetic surgery
- · Long-term care (also called custodial care)

In a typical year, they admit about 2,000 animals into their medical facility, treating injured or sick patients and raising orphans. This year, however, COVID-19 public health protocols prevented them from admitting patients and orphans starting in mid-March to the present. DIVORCE 101:

Divorce v. Dissolution: What is the difference?

This article simplistically identifies the main issues in the termination of the marital contract and explains the difference between a divorce and dissolution. The issues in the termination of the marital contract are as follows: (1.) Allocation of Parental Rights and Responsibilities if there are children. The main issues regarding the allocation of parental rights and responsibilities would include who pays child support and how much, companionship time, formerly known as "visitation", who has custody or how is shared parenting, formerly known as "joint custody", to be allocated, who is responsible for health care/ insurance and how will the tax exemption be divided. (2.) Spousal support. Will one party pay the other spousal support and how much and for how long? (3.) Property distribution. How will the marital real and personal property and all other marital assets be divided. (4.) Pension and retirement

division, if in existence. And, finally, (5.) Allocation of marital debt. These are the main issues in every divorce and/or dissolution.

The most fundamental difference between a contested divorce and a dissolution and/ or uncontested divorce is that in a contested divorce, the parties cannot agree on one or more of the issues; whereas, in dissolution or an uncontested divorce, the parties are in agreement. Dissolutions and uncontested divorces are very cost effective and can be finalized in as little as six weeks from the date of the filing. The cost of the divorce or dissolution will vary on the number of issues in the case. In a dissolution or uncontested (no fighting) divorce the financial cost can be dramatically less than a contested divorce (the parties cannot agree on one or more of the issues) but, most importantly, the emotional cost to both parties and their children, if applicable, is much lower.

An action for divorce- if the parties cannot come to a voluntary agreement- can easily take a year or longer to finalize. There is the

dread of runaway attorney fees averaging \$250- \$300 per hour. In a contested divorce (where the people are actively fighting) there is always the worry (which is justified) that the attorney will quit if you run out of money or the fear of receiving another several thousand dollar bill unexpectedly. information gathering process referred to as "discovery" can become a costly and stressful nightmare. Discovery is not required with dissolution.

The emotional price continuous daily resentment, depression, fear and worry can become overbearing and destructive to one's health. Dissolution avoids all of this. That being said; It is very difficult to get two people who are usually not the best of friends to begin with to agree on all issues. All issues must be agreed to for a successful dissolution to occur. This requires compromise. The cardinal rule is that nobody walks away happy. Each party usually feels wronged in some way by the other. Each party usually feels that they could have obtained a better result if they would have just held out longer or been more aggressive. The truth is the law is pretty settled on how property and children are resolved. In most cases, you will not get a better result by engaging in prolonged litigation.

If the parties are unable to come to an agreement regarding all the issues, as is often the case, a divorce must be initiated. I try to resolve as many issues as possible before hand and communicate with the other party or his/her attorney to coordinate the process. It is always best to work together and focus upon resolution of the issues on which the parties agree. The purpose of the attorney is to make the process as minimally painful, and least expensive as possible. Open and honest communication is key. Unfortunately, in many cases, the parties have so much resentment toward each other that they are simply unable to cooperate. This is never in anybody's best interest and can be very damaging to children.

There are certainly ways to minimize the pain and cost of a divorce but it will never be as efficient and emotionally healthy as two parties coming to a voluntary agreement with dissolution. I believe that a dissolution really should be possible in most cases if two factors are present (1.) the parties are mature, sensitive and intelligent and (2.) the matter is approached with a cost versus benefit business analysis, an open mind and sound professional guidance. I know this is easier said than done. But- if accomplishedthe financial and emotional rewards (including healing time) reaped are enormous for the parties and children and will be enjoyed for the span of one's entire life.


