TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

For April 5, 2016

- I. CALL TO ORDER:** Mayor Douglas Arnold called the meeting to order at 7:08 p.m. Council members present at the meeting were: Larry LaBolle, Steve Leitz, Patricia Neumann and Cathy Dunkle. Garry Greenwalt was absent. Also present was Clerk/Treasurer, Heidi Turnbough.
- II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Mayor Douglas Arnold asked those present to join him in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- III. REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES AND TOWN EMPLOYEES:** There was none.
- IV. READING OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:** The meeting minutes for March 01, 2016 were presented. Patricia Neumann made a motion to accept the meeting minutes as written. Cathy Dunkle seconded the motion; all council members voted yes.
- V. PRESENTATION OF VOUCHERS, WARRANTS, FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND REPORTS:** The Clerk/Treasurer presented check numbers 7583, and 7594-7605 totaling \$4,263.99 as well as payroll check numbers 7584 through 7593 with EFT payments for 941 totaling \$2,900.87. Cathy Dunkle motion to accept the financial statements as presented. Larry LaBolle seconded the motion; all council members voted yes.
- VI. PRESENTATION OF PETITIONS, APPLICATIONS, CONCERNS, APPEALS, COMMUNICATIONS, ETC:**
- The Clerk presented a request from USPS to reverse a late fee on account that the new post master was unable to pay on time. Larry LaBolle made a motion to reverse the \$10.00 late fee for March 2016. Cathy Dunkle seconded the motion; all council members voted yes.
- Wendy Miller was present to state a concern about two potential dangerous dogs running at large. Garry Greenwalt was not in attendance so Mayor Arnold will contact Mr. Greenwalt to confirm that he is following policy and declaring the dogs dangerous because the dogs charged children at the park on April 6, 2016.
- VII. OLD BUSINESS:**
- A. WELL HOUSE PROJECT:** Layne Merritt was present to update the council on the well house project and the dates the project will begin. Colors for the well house were chosen by the council.
- B. RECYCLE PROGRAM:** The clerk gave the council four letters and informed them of two phone calls regarding keeping the recycle bin. Mike VanHeel was a citizen present to advocate the recycle

program. Mr. VanHeel encouraged the council to continue the recycle program. This council decided to keep the program and address at a later date, if recycle fees increased.

VIII. NEW BUSINESS:

- A. CHIPPING EVENT:** The council did not vote to participate with the town of Fairfield in the April chipping event.
- B. UNDERGROUND ELECTRICAL AT CHURCH PROPERTY:** The council discussed paying for the supplies to allow Avista to bury overhead power at the church property to allow a safe landing pad for MedStar as a community service. The clerk was asked to find a fund and account to properly charge up to a \$1,500.00 expense.

X. ADJOURNMENT:

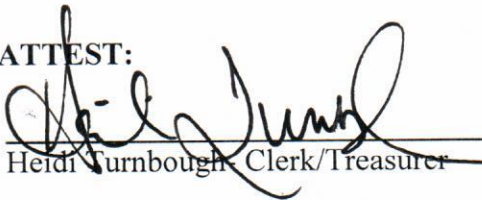
Patricia Neumann made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:37 p.m. Steve Leitz seconded the motion; all council members voted yes.
