BALDWIN SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

The scholarship shall be awarded annually to a Baldwin resident and graduate of Sacopee Valley High School. Eligible students must be enrolled in either an accredited college consisting of two or four years, or enrolled in vocational technical school. The scholarship is funded with the balance of the Baldwin School Fund, which in 2015 stood at \$5,460.00. This scholarship is to be continued until all funds are expended.

- 1. Scholarship: \$1,100.00 annually to students (can have multiple recipients) in good standing (C or equivalent average for the previous semester). Students may apply each year they are eligible.
- Schedule: Advertisement placed in the Shopping Guide on or about 1 September annually with applications due on or about 1 October. Selection by the Board of Selectmen before on or about 1 November. Primary recipient and alternates selected for each award. Awards announced in November for the following semester payout.
- 3. Applications available after any time from the Selectmen's office. A brief resume shall be required with the application.
- 4. Scholarships paid completion of first or subsequent semester. Recipient must provide copy of the previous semester's transcript and verification of enrollment for the current semester.
- 5. Records shall be kept on who received the scholarship, the date and the amount received. (Scholarship winners announced in the Shopping Guide).
