

## Find It!

### Overview

The student is presented with a fun visual scene in which many target letter symbols are embedded. A symbol list is provided so students know what they are looking for. This activity works on beginning sound skills.

### Customize

1. Remove the symbol list to make the activity even more challenging.
2. Use a bingo marker if circling with a writing utensil is difficult for the student.
3. Tape the scene to a magnetic board (magnetic board/tape can be found in the Mayer-Johnson catalog). Create mini target letters with magnets on the back. Have the student place the target letter on the item when it is found.
4. Place Velcro® over each of the symbols the student is searching for (you may want to place some extra pieces of Velcro as distracters as well to maintain the difficulty). The student will then Velcro mini target letters on each object as they find it.
5. Have the student write the letter with a marker over each symbol as the items are found.

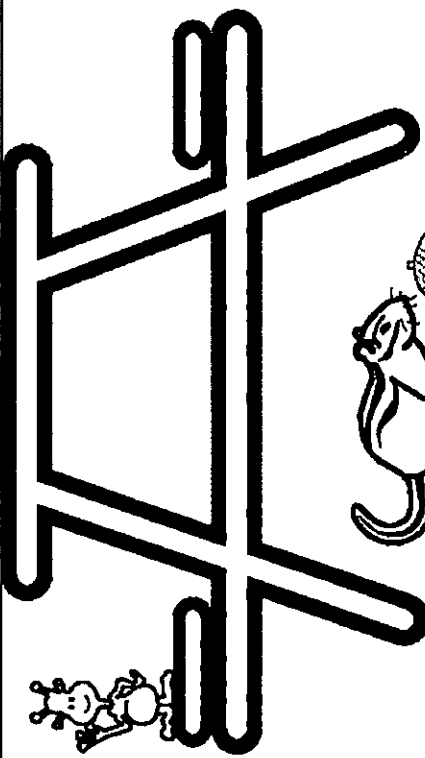
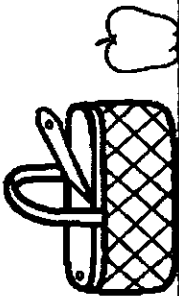
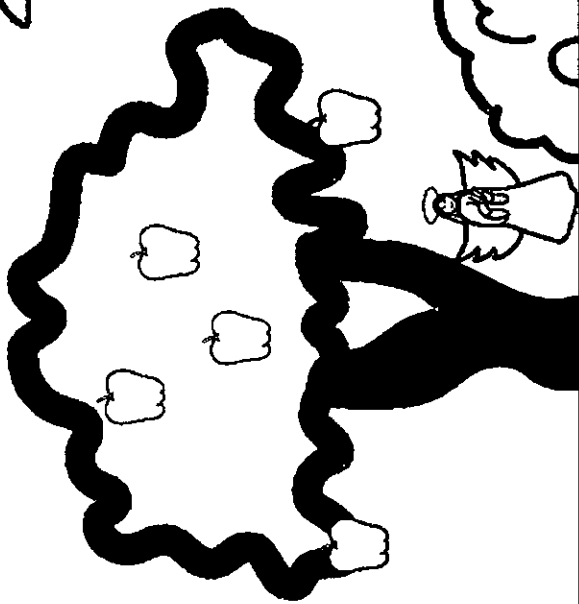
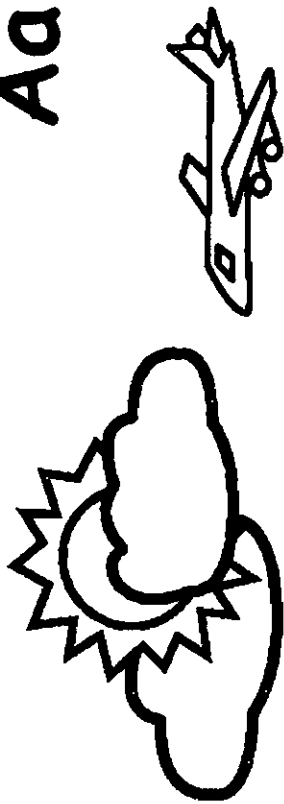
### Extension Activities

1. Have the student search through magazines or book illustrations to find pictures that start with the target letter.
2. Have a scavenger hunt around the classroom, at a park, or in a community setting to find items that start with the target letter.
3. Use Find It! along with Count It! to add a math component to this activity.
4. Cut out the symbols in each scene, place magnetic tape on the back, and allow the student to make his/her own scene by placing the symbols on a magnetic board. He or she can present the scene to another student to find the target items.
