Habakkuk 2:1-4 (KJV)

So, if you would like to join us in being a **Prayer Warrior**, here's all you need to do:

1. Be willing to commit to praying for needs given to you at least once a day for 30 days (or more often/longer it's up to you);
2. Submit your prayer requests for other Warriors to pray over.
3. If you submit a prayer request card, you will be given a card for someone else in return.
4. If you are unable to commit to praying each day, we ask that you please submit your prayers on the Prayer Request cards for the weekly Bulletin.

Prayer Warrior request cards are located on the back bookshelf next to the water fountain. Please fill out a card with the information listed below and then return it to the box clearly marked, "**Prayer Warriors**"

On the card:

1. Your name (so we can pray for you directly)
2. Any special requests for yourself that you would like to have prayed about (spiritual, physical, work, family, etc.);
3. Any special requests for someone else and their needs;
4. Any special requests for someone whom you may be carrying a burden for;
5. Any other requests that you would like to have prayed about or are seeking answering on.

Please place your cards into the box on or before **Wednesday, Oct. 16th**. We will distribute received cards to those who are participating on **Sunday, Oct. 20th**, so watch your mailboxes.
