

**Marysville Township**  
**MONTHLY BOARD MEETING**  
**Monday April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

**Meeting:** The meeting was called to order by Chair Augie Riebel at 7:00 PM. Members present: Augie Riebel Chair, Joe Hickman Vice-Chair, Jane Hurley Supervisor, Debbie Uecker Clerk-Treasurer, Marty Randal Deputy Clerk-Treasurer, Ron Boehlke Road Maintenance, Bob Casey Road Maintenance and 10 residents.

**Pledge of Allegiance:** Recited.

**Meeting Minutes:** A motion to accept the March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Meeting Minutes was made by Jane Hurley, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe Hickman and carried 3-0.

A motion to accept the Special Executive Board Meeting Minutes dated March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019 was made by Jane Hurley, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe Hickman and carried 3-0.

A motion to accept the April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Local Board of Appeal & Equalization Meeting Minutes was made by Joe Hickman, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jane Hurley and carried 3-0.

**Treasurers Report:** The beginning balance for April 2019 is \$79,154.13, receipts of \$2,650.00, expenses of \$37,381.96 and ending balance of \$44,422.17. A motion to accept the Treasurers' report was made by Jane Hurley, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe Hickman and carried 3-0.

**Old Business:**

- 1) None

**New Business:**

- 1) Howard Bremmer was present to discuss his application for a variance to build a 24' x 30' onto his existing garage. He bought the property in January 2019 and the lot is a 2-acre parcel. The building would be 58 feet from the centerline of the Township road and the requirement is 65 feet from the centerline. After discussions a motion was made by Jane Hurley, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe Hickman to approve the addition to the garage of 24' x 30' on the existing blacktop with no more additions to the property and carried 3-0.

- 2) Russ Graham with the Deer/Goose Lake association was present to introduce himself. The Association has re-started, they currently have 16 households. They are concerned about the 10<sup>th</sup> street landing, concentrating on water management and lake shore management. Russ Graham commented on the great grading and plowing on 5<sup>th</sup> street.

- 3) Bill Uter was present to apply for a variance to add 12 feet to the end of barn to put in robotics, the current building is built within 45 feet of the road set back not the 65 that is required. After discussions a motion was made by Joe Hickman, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jane Hurley to approve the variance to add 12 feet to the barn as per the plans submitted and carried 3-0.

- 4) Health Insurance was reviewed and renewed.

- 5) A motion to change the May Meeting date from May 27<sup>th</sup> to May 20<sup>th</sup> due to the Memorial Day Holiday was made by Jane Hurley, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe Hickman and carried 3-0.

- 6) A motion to renew CD's #19799 for a 12-month term at .40% APR was made by Jane Hurley, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe Hickman and carried 3-0.

**Business from the Floor:**

1) Dale Nygaard was present to discuss his gravel pit in Marysville Township. He is questioning when the gravel permit was permitted if it was a requirement to have Kolles restore the pit. Dale will check with Wright County Planning and Zoning for dates of the gravel pit.

2) Fred Bonk questioned if the Township is wanting to crush gravel this year for the next two years. He can have the gravel and crushing done for \$5.00 per yard. A motion was made by Jane Hurley, 2<sup>nd</sup> Joe Hickman to crush 15,000 yards of gravel at a cost of \$5.00 per yard and carried 3-0.

3) 2019 cleanup day was discussed; we went thru a 50-yard dumpster and two 30-yard dumpsters of garbage. We collected 3 dumpsters of scrap iron and had over 100 people in attendance. A huge thank you to all volunteers for helping.

4) Pat Lindquist questioned if we could re-look at 10<sup>th</sup> street as the road has had water running over the road. When the water goes down, we will re-look at the culvert and possibly building the road up.
