TOUR OF MILWAUKEE 2019

Join us on Thursday August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to see some of the sights of Milwaukee.

The tour will start with a view of the Lake Michigan shore line as well as the Milwaukee Art Center, featuring the Calatrava.

We'll then take a tour of the beautifully restored Pabst Mansion, the home of Captain Frederick Pabst, the founder of the Pabst Brewing Company. This home was completed in July of 1892. It was placed on the National Register of Historic Places on April 21<sup>st</sup>, 1975.

After the mansion tour, we will proceed to the Tripoli Shrine Center for a tour and lunch. Our building was completed in 1928 and in 1986 it was placed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Our final destination will be to the Miller Valley, home of the Miller Brewing Company for over 155 years. After this walking tour you will be able to sample 3 FREE ice cold Miller products. There will also be soda and water available for those who do not drink beer.

We will be leaving in the morning and returning around 4PM. The cost of this tour is \$35, which includes the bus.
