

Pre-Season Courtesy Inspection March 10th

Racers – The inspection teams have volunteered to provide all racers the opportunity to have their race vehicle and safety equipment checked before the season starts. We all know how crappy it feels to show up at inspection and be told you have to fix a problem.

This inspection opportunity is especially important if you have a newly built race vehicle, are planning to make a major class change, or if you have made other significant changes during the off-season. The inspectors will have the 2018 helmet inspection stickers and will check expiration dates of safety equipment. They will also conduct a thorough inspection to see if your vehicle, driver/rider clothing and safety equipment complies with the current requirements and the rule changes for 2018. This is the best time to ask questions and to find out if there will be any problems while giving you plenty of time to make corrections. Inspectors can also verify the integrity of the engine seals or measure and seal your engine in a cleaner environment than the dusty lakebed. Also a Sonic Tester will be available at the site to check roll structures.

This is a courtesy inspection only. Your race vehicle must be inspected at every SCTA event you enter.
