Pledge of Allegiance

1. As we began to chat about what, if anything, we wanted to accomplish as a committee, before being finished, the following things were found: In the last and current Charge, (which Anne called up on the computer from somewhere) the CPC is to be sunseted once the Plan is passed by the citizens. CPC charges previously had sunseted after the Plan was passed by the State, and we thought we were still a committee. But evidently, we are post-sunset, hence "Twilight" meeting.
2. We did go on and discuss our hopes for the implementation of the Plan and what effect we may still have as a committee and the loose intention was voiced to ask the Select Board to bring the sun back up on the CPC, so that the original/ongoing/not met yet part of its charge can be completed: to develop a management plan for the highway corridors and resulting ordinances, as part of the implementation of the Future Land Use Plan, which calls for zoning.
3. The following will be suggested to the Select Board: as per the CPC's recommendations for implementation of the Plan (submitted August 2014), two committees be tasked with 1) the writing of a zoning plan, and 2) the general implementation of the new Comp Plan. One way to "hit the ground running", would be to reinstate the CPC which could begin work on the zoning plan right away.

Unless reinstated, this is the final meeting and final minutes of the CPC.
