i. Regarding unfaithfulness

1. Justice restored (Numbers 5:5-10) -

iii. (v. 6-7) – Completely avoid going near a dead body.

h. The supplication (prayer) to be uttered from the Tabernacle – (Numbers 6:22-27)

i. Aaron and sons, the priests, are instructed to pronounce this blessing over the people. (24-26)

i. The support for the Tabernacle – (Numbers 7:1-89)

i. Gifts/offerings are present by the leaders of Israel’s twelve tribes, one day for 12 days:

Day 1 – Judah (v.12-17), Day 2- Issachar (v.18-23), Day 3 Zebulun (v. 24-29), Day 4 – Reuben (v.30-35), Day 5 - Simeon (v. 36-41), Day 6 -Gad (v. 42-47), Day 7- Ephraim (v.48-48-53), Day 8 - Manasseh (v. 54-59), Day 9 - Benjamin (60-65), Day 10 - Dan (v. 66-71), Day 11 - Asher (72-77), Day 12 -Naphtali (v. 78-83).
