There being a quorum, Mayor Simmons called the meeting of the Vienna City Council to order at 6:30 p.m.

Alderman Racey made a motion to approve the Omnibus Consent Agenda consisting of the June 6, 2018 City Council Meeting Minutes and the Warrant (\$23,023.32). Alderman Hill seconded the motion. Roll call: **Hill-yes, Riddle-yes, Myrick- yes, Owen-yes, Racey-yes, and Tuey- yes. Motion carried.**

NEW BUSINESS

Alderman Owen made a motion to Authorize and Approve Ordinance No.18-05, an Appropriation Ordinance for the 2018 Fiscal Year for the City of Vienna, IL. The motion was seconded by Alderman Riddle. Roll call: **Hill-yes, Riddle-yes, Myrick- yes, Owen-yes, Racey-yes, and Tuey-yes. Motion carried.**

Alderman Tuey made a motion to Authorize and Approve Ordinance 18-06, A Levy Ordinance for the City of Vienna, IL. Alderman Myrick seconded the motion. Roll call: **Hill-yes, Riddle-yes, Myrick- yes, Owen-yes, Racey-yes, Tuey- yes. Motion carried.**

Alderman Hill made a motion to Authorize and Approve to amend the original motion made for the purchase of new radio gas/water meters for all utility customers (12/20/17 , \$150,000.00 TIF Funds). The new motion would increase funds \$60,000.00 for the remainder of project costs as follows: \$5,000.00 TIF Funds and the remainder to be divided between all Utility Funds. The motion was seconded by Alderman Tuey. Roll call: **Hill-yes, Riddle-yes, Myrick- yes, Owen-yes, Racey-yes, and Tuey-yes. Motion carried.**

PUBLIC COMMENT

Chris Banks, Wildfires restaurant owner was present to request assistance from the city with interstate signage as the city had assisted other small local businesses. Alderman Racey made a motion for the city to assist with the purchase of interstate signage not to exceed \$1,924.00 (Tourism Funds). Alderman Tuey seconded the motion. Roll call: **Hill-yes, Riddle-yes, Myrick-yes, Owen-yes, Racey-yes and Tuey-yes. Motion carried.**

Max Hook was present to discuss with council a project at the ballpark of installing a wireless scoreboard at field #4. Request was made to the city to assist with costs. Hook said the costs would be divided between the schools and JCYL. Clerk was directed to place the item on the next meeting's agenda for action.

CITY ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS

Mayor Simmons discussed the closing of IGA mentioning potential interested buyers. Alderman Tuey added that he made contact with several chain stores. Brief discussion was had.

Wright discussed increasing the Zoning Boards compensation. Discussion was had. Alderman Owen made a motion to have city attorney to draw up necessary paperwork to increase members pay by \$10 per meeting making the new rate \$25 per meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderman Tuey. Motion carried.

City Supt Racey mentioned waterline work being completed on 6th & College St. Racey also discussed repairs needed to a skid steer.

Police Chief Miller discussed ordinance violation citations.

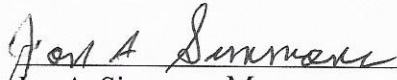
Fire Chief Williams said the department received a Fire Marshall Grant in the amount of \$28,899.25. Williams said this would assist with the purchase of turnout gear.

Alderman Riddle discussed concern of residents that had reached out to her after learning that there were several former ex felons/ registered sex offenders living on North 6th Street.

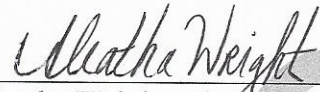
As there was no further business to discuss Alderman Owen made a motion to adjourn seconded by Alderman Myrick.
