LOCATION Mount Sequoyah Retreat Center, 150 N Skyline Drive, Fayetteville AR

Just 5 minutes from the Fayetteville Square, the Center provides multiple facilities on 33 beautiful wooded acres at the top of Mount Sequoyah. 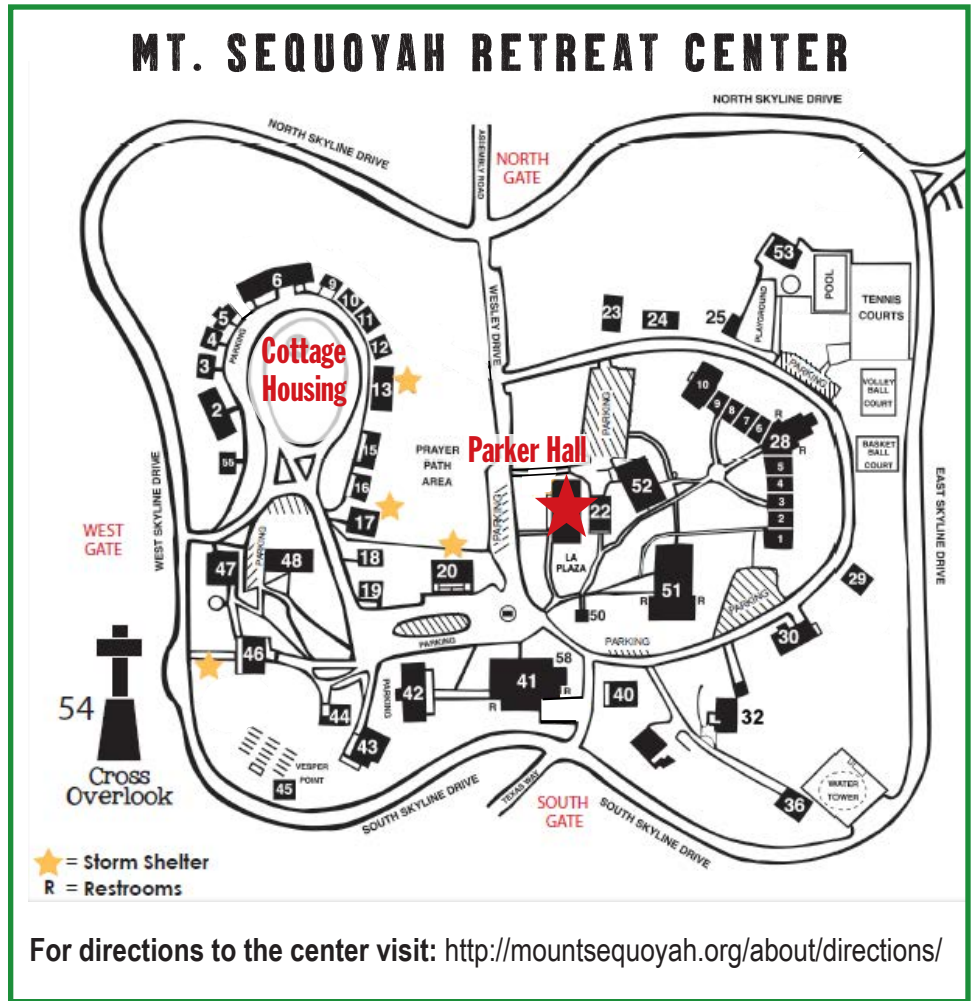

ACCOMODATIONS We have booked a block of rooms for the event in two locations. Fifteen very basic rooms are available above the main hall for \$45 a night with 20 more private cottage rooms close to the main hall for \$75 a night.
