The Board received an email from Glenn Insurance regarding the AFFF stored in the pole barn. The email states that the insurance company "checked with their Risk Control Department and there isn't anything more that the insured can do at this point. They did everything they're supposed to and are just waiting on the outside company to come and dispose of it"
