To create Federal Law dealing with pedophiles and the trafficking of minors.

In the House of Representatives

The Pedophile and Trafficking Hate Crime Act of 2021

Section 1

Congress hereby designates any person found guilty of committing a sexual act against a minor as a pedophile and the crime shall be considered a federal hate crime.

Section 2

In addition to the punishment authorized by state or federal law, anyone found guilty of this new federal hate crime must always be physically castrated by a duly licensed physician within one week of all appeals being exhausted. No appeal shall be allowed of the castration portion of the conviction.

Section 3

Anyone convicted of trafficking any minor shall also be considered as having committed a federal hate crime. In addition to punishment authorized by state or federal law, anyone found guilty of this new federal hate crime must always be physically castrated by a duly licensed physician within one week of all appeals being exhausted. No appeal shall be allowed of the castration portion of the conviction.

Section 4

The definition of a "minor" shall be considered anyone under the age of fourteen at the time the crime is committed.
