

Call for Native American Student Interns

Spend two days aboard the NOAA research vessel Shearwater to assist in conducting geophysical surveys to map the seafloor surrounding California's Channel Islands



This is an opportunity to learn from researchers at the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, San Diego State University, CSU San Bernardino, and UC Santa Barbara

- Learn about multibeam, side scan, and Chirp sonar
- Help identify submerged paleolandscapes and sensitive biological features
