


Luke 4:1-13 Jessus Was Tempted in the Wilderness






1. You are called to a <u>Galilean</u> journey of the Cross.



1. You are called to a <u>Galilean</u> journey of the Cross.


In this work, which marked the arrival of a new era of Hispanic/Latino theology in the United States, Virgilio Elizondo described the Galilee principle:

Are stairs a strain?


Is it difficult to look over your shoulder while backing up your car?
