Upon entrance to the Colorado State Fairgrounds, attendees will be required to sign a waiver/pledge to acknowledge the possible risk of exposure to coronavirus and pledge to do all you can to help us minimize that risk. You will be given a wrist band once you sign the waiver that will allow you entrance to the venue. If you do not have the wristband on, you will simply need to sign a new waiver.

Please do not congregate in large groups, especially with people who are not part of your 'barn family' while at the show. Groups need to be restricted in size and distancing appropriately. This will include gathering at the end-gate of the arena.

We have all gotten used to when we need a mask and when we don't. Masks are required when you are not competing and if you cannot maintain social distance from people not in your immediate barn family group.

Because it is also flu season, keep washing your hands and using proper coughing sneezing protocol, covering your face with the crook of your elbow, and move at least 6 feet away from others!

We will park RV campers in every other spot. RV Spots will be reserved and marked in your name.
