Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
Mark 6:7-13

Dear St. Pius X and St. Anthony Church Family,

Peace! Ready for a mission? Jesus sends out his apostles in the gospel today! And Jesus calls each one of us to follow Him, too! **He calls everyone** to be His disciples. And he will provide for each person, his/her own work to accomplish. But what about Jesus sending those twelve apostles on mission *without extra supplies*? He says in Mark 6:8, to go taking “nothing for the journey, but a walking stick—*no food, no sack, no money in their belts*”. We don’t load up with our own self-reliant tools. He asks for trust/faith in Him. Taking extra provisions may make us comfortable, but Jesus is building trust in us. For what Jesus wants us to do, **He will provide**. And His task may not be what we think best. There’s a saying in ministry, that “God does not call the qualified; no, he qualifies the called!” If my own preparation for a task is my personal achievement, then I wrongly take pride in my work instead of relying wholeheartedly in faith on what God was doing in me. God is at work in ways unimaginable to me. Sometimes even, accomplishing His will may not even be on my radar. But that is what keeps us as disciples humble. It is His work, not mine. As they say, “I am not the carpenter, I am only the tool in the carpenter’s hand!”

I know it was a crisis in seminary for me to realize one day, that while I may be trained by excellent teachers, that does not mean I am being called to do what they are training me for. Each seminarian comes to a point in formation when they ask themselves, “I may achieve a degree of competence with priestly duties, but does God want me to serve Him this way?” It comes down not to being a question of “am I able to do this” but “am I called to do this”. But that is for a very specific form of discipleship: priesthood. God calls all of us uniquely to different vocations, to any career, married or single. Regardless of one’s gifts or state in life, we are all called to follow Jesus, wherever we find ourselves. Pope Francis wrote in a meditation on holiness, “*We are frequently tempted to think that holiness is only for those who can withdraw from ordinary affairs to spend much time in prayer. That is not the case. We are all called to be holy by living our lives with love and by bearing witness in everything we do, wherever we find ourselves* (GE #14). The Pope says it, ‘*Wherever we find ourselves*’.
